Etymology

Word from the native lexical stock; from **Old English** *wērig*, 'tired'; from **Germanic** *wōrīgaz*, 'unwell'.

Etymologically Related Words

Origins: **WŌRĪGAZ** Germanic > **WĒRIG** Old English > **weary**.

WŌRĪGAZ Germanic

— **WĒRIG** Old English – **weary** → weary, weariness, unwearied, wearing, world-weary (→ world-weariness), wearily, wearisome (→ wearisomely), unwearying.

— **WEARY** Early Modern English – **awearry**.
