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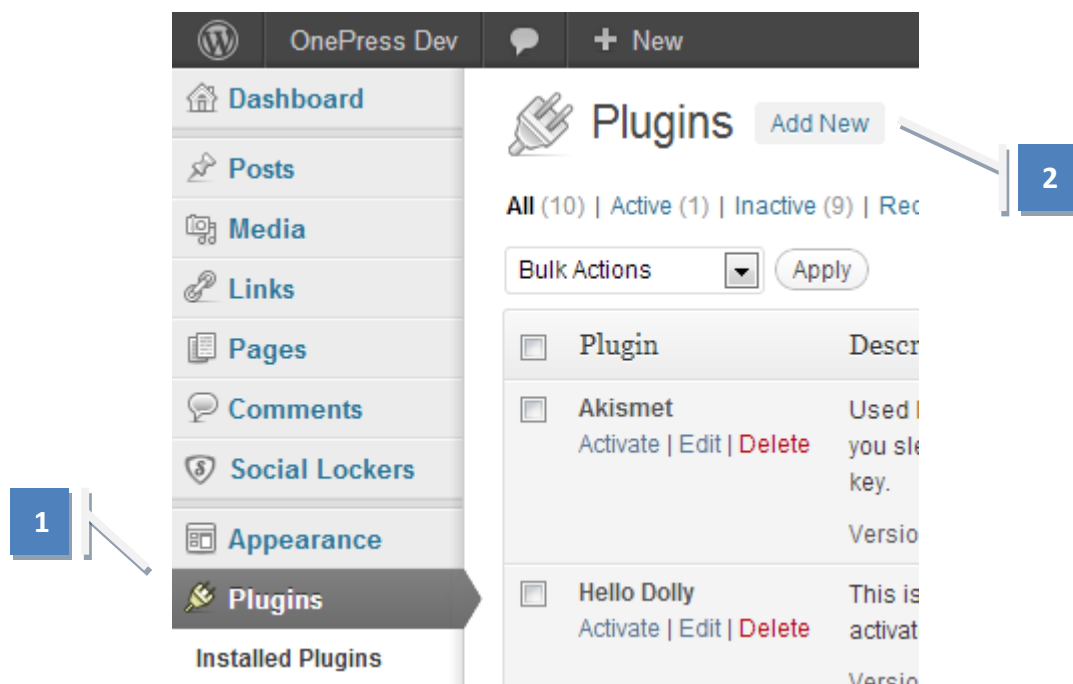
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[Installation]

To install the plugin, just upload the plugin archive on your server and activate through your Wordpress Dashboard. Then verify your license key on the License Manage page of the plugin.

Step #1. Install on Wordpress

1. Select the menu «**Plugins**».
2. Click on the button «**Add New**».



3. Click on the link «**Upload**».
4. Upload the file «**plugin-clipboard-images--*.*-premium-en-US.zip**» from the archive you downloaded and click on the button «**Install Now**».



5. Wait until the installation is complete and click the link «**Activate Plugin**».

Step #2. Register your plugin instance

After the activation, you should register your instance of plugin and enter a valid license key.

[Usage]

In order to use the plugin put some image into the clipboard, then open the post editor (Visual or HTML mode) and paste it. After a while, the image will appear inside the post content. Images are stored in Media Library as if you would use the standard way to insert image.

Use the button above the editor to enable and disable the plugin:
