## A new market is coming to Cumberland

### **The Cumberland Farmers' Market is introducing a new Winter Market this season.**

Local artisans and producers are inviting residents to discover their handcrafted goods, culinary specialties and homemade holiday treats on Dec. 6 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The market will include free horse-drawn wagon rides hosted by interpreters of the Cumberland Heritage Village Museum. Round trip tours will begin at the market and will head towards the museum where a short visit is scheduled.
