## EDITORIAL

### **America at 245; Communist Party of China at 100**

July 1 (EIRNS)—Heading into the July Fourth weekend in the United States, it is useful to think about the founding of the United States together with the celebration in China today of the centennial of the founding of the Communist Party of China (CPC). The U.S. has survived as a republic for

245 years, although often failing to live up to that Platonic concept, while the CPC has survived as a party for a century, and as the ruling party of China for over 70 years, with some very dark moments and some great advances. The history is important, but more important is the directionality. How do you perceive the future development of the United States, and its role in the world going forward? How do you perceive the future development of China, and its role in the world going forward? If you have not thought this through, it is past time you do so.

Lyndon LaRouche never failed to insist that what makes us humans, rather than animals, is that we can look at the world today from fifty years in the future, or even thousands of years in the future, which no animal can do. We can then determine what needs to be discovered about the laws of the universe, and how to apply those discoveries to the development of new technologies required to make the world a better place for far more people living at a higher standard of living, economically and culturally. This requires a rising rate of the rate of increase of what he called “potential relative population density.” How does that measure apply today to the United States, and to China?

Over the past fifty years, since approximately the assassination of John F. Kennedy, the rate of potential relative population density in the U.S. has slowed dramatically, and went into decline sometime over the past three decades. Kennedy’s plan for fusion power by the end of the 20th century was scrapped, and even the building of nuclear power plants was sabotaged, and now the insane Green New Deal is shutting down fossil fuel plants and building wasteful, unreliable wind and solar parks. The American System of Hamiltonian economics, with the government directing credit into the infrastructure required for private entrepreneurs to have access to clean water, cheap power, adequate transportation, and a healthy and well-educated workforce, has been systematically replaced by the British System demand for the “independence of the Fed”—i.e., no government “interference” in the financial direction of the economy imposed by the banks, which have turned to speculation rather than production. The result is: The destruction of American industry through

“globalization”; the collapse of American infrastructure; the failure to provide water resources to the Western states, causing their desertification today; the privatization and deconstruction of health care, leading to the abject failure to counter a virus and the deaths of hundreds of thousands; a virtual disappearance of Classical education and Classical culture in favor of the libertarian proliferation of drugs, sexual perversity, and the glorification of ugliness; the conduct of perpetual, genocidal warfare against weaker nations which were no threat to the U.S. And now, preparation for military confrontation with nuclear powers Russia and China. Virtually no one thinks about the nation fifty years from today.

In China, there is more application of the Hamiltonian “American System” of directed credit to provide for the general welfare, as called for in the Preamble to the U.S. Constitution, than has been seen in the U.S. for decades. President Xi Jinping, addressing the nation from the balcony of the Forbidden City facing Tiananmen Square, spoke today to a proud people about the struggle to survive the “century of humiliation” under British colonial control and the Japanese invasion. Xi said: “We Chinese are a people who uphold justice and are not intimidated by threats of force. As a nation, we have a strong sense of pride and confidence. We have never bullied, oppressed, or subjugated the people of any other country, and we never will. By the same token, we will never allow any foreign force to bully, oppress, or subjugate us. Anyone who would attempt to do so will find themselves on a collision course with a great wall of steel forged by over 1.4 billion Chinese people.”

Such thinking may be considered utopian by some, but it was the common thinking of the founders of our nation, as it was of Franklin Roosevelt, and as it is of the leaders of China and Russia today. America has fallen far, but is not hopeless. The spark of optimism and commitment in the great Americans of the past, of Lyndon and Helga LaRouche, of the Chinese leaders today, can be restored, if our citizens make that choice.

## STRATEGIC WAR DANGER

### **Putin: Even Sinking the *HMS Defender* Would Not Have Triggered a War**

July 1 (EIRNS)—During his nationally broadcast “Direct Line with Vladimir Putin” annual question & answer session with the Russian public yesterday, President Putin argued, in response to one question, that even if the Russian military had sunk the *HMS Defender*, on June 23, it would not have triggered a World War III. “You said that this put the world on the brink of a global war. No, of course, not. Even if we had sunk that ship, it is

nevertheless difficult to imagine that this would have put the world on the brink of a third world war because those who did this know they could not win a war like that. This is very important,” he said. (Putin would do well to recall the advice of Lyndon LaRouche, who frequently said that one should never discount the possibility that one’s interlocutors on the other side of the table might actually be insane.) The President further stressed: “I do not think that we would have been happy at the turn of events you mentioned, but we at least know what we are fighting for: We are fighting for ourselves and our future on our own territory. It was not we who covered thousands of kilometers by air and sea towards them; it was they who approached our borders and entered our territorial sea....”

Putin continued: “The second thing is the political component. Recently, a few days ago, a meeting was held in Geneva. The question was: why was there such a provocation? What was all of that for? For the sake of emphasizing that these people do not respect the Crimeans’ choice to join the Russian Federation? ... Fine, keep not accepting it. But why a provocation of this kind?” the President asked.

President Putin explained his answer: “I am not concerned about this or that somebody does not respect the choice of the people in Crimea to join Russia. I have a different concern. Look now, they raised a clamor over the fact that we were conducting exercises on our own territory near the Ukrainian border. I instructed the Defense Ministry to quietly end the drills and withdraw the troops, if this is such a great concern for them. We did so. But instead of responding positively and saying ‘OK, we understand your reaction to our indignation,’ what did they do? They approached our borders.”

Putin stressed that there is more involved, related to the militarization of Ukraine. “I am worried about another, more fundamental thing, namely, the beginning of military development in Ukrainian territory. Under the Ukrainian Constitution, no foreign bases can be established in the country. Training centers and other facilities and formats are possible. But the military development of a territory that directly borders on our country

creates a considerable security problem for us. This has to do with the vital interests of the Russian Federation and the Russian people. Of course, this is alarming, and we must think about it,” President Putin cautioned.

The President’s nearly three-hour dialogue, responding to 70 questions, is posted to the Kremlin website.

## **U.S. Congress Pushes Militarization of Space**

July 1 (EIRNS)—Two events at the end of June involving members of the U.S. Congress, playing up the alleged threat to U.S. satellites from China and Russia, show that such scare-mongering is all the rage in Washington, D.C. “We are so dependent on space for everything we do in our daily lives, we really have no idea. It’s not just our TV, our internet; it’s our ATMs, our banking, all forms of internet and communication,” Rep. Jim Cooper (D-TN), chairman of the House Armed Services Subcommittee on Strategic Forces, said at *The Hill*’s “Future of Missile Defense” event on June 29. “Increasingly, rival nations are looking at ways of taking out our satellites. Hitherto, the space assets we have, have been unprotected and we didn’t fear for them at all. Now other nations are spending many billions of dollars to try to develop capabilities to destroy our satellites in that unfriendly domain,” Cooper said.

Rep. Mike Turner (R-OH), the ranking Republican on the subcommittee, said the U.S. is taking steps to guard against any attempt to sabotage satellites. “We’re working diligently to both strengthen our space assets and to respond to what our adversaries are doing. It’s been widely publicized that Russia and China have both tested systems that would attack satellites and would destroy them. We need to make certain that we can sustain our space capabilities,” Turner said.

The same day, House Armed Services Committee Chairman Adam Smith (D-WA) told *Air Force Magazine* that satellite survivability and redundancy were his priorities for fending off adversaries, but a closer look at the budget would be necessary. “I don’t think ‘catch-up,’ is the right word,” Smith said when asked during a Defense Writers Group discussion about American space weapons compared to those of adversaries. “We’re

not behind in this area,” he replied. The Washington State Democrat said his priorities were cost-effective launch and the survivability of satellites and command-and-control systems.

No one has the courage to suggest, however, that China and Russia might be reacting to the U.S. extension of its geopolitical policy against both countries into space, a process which began well before the establishment of the U.S. Space Force in 2019.

### **Proconsul Nuland Dictates ‘Anti-Corruption’ Ultimatums to Panama and El Salvador**

July 1 (EIRNS)—Reprising the role of imperial proconsul that she perfected in the 2014 Maidan coup d’état in Ukraine, Undersecretary of State for Political Affairs Victoria Nuland wrapped up her June 27-30 tour of South and Central America with one-day visits to Panama and El Salvador, threatening those governments that if they failed to bow to the State Department’s democracy and “anti-corruption” agenda, Wall Street and City of London financial interests would make them pay. In El Salvador, whose President Nayib Bukele has been labeled an “authoritarian” for making sovereign political decisions not to Washington’s liking, she delivered a barely-disguised threat of regime change, should he fail to follow the “rules-based order.”

In an interview with Panama’s *La Prensa*, Nuland baldly threatened that unless President Laurentino Cortizo were more aggressive in punishing money-laundering and related crimes, it would send the “wrong message” to international rating agencies which want assurances that Panama is a “good investment risk.” Since Panama is one of the world’s largest offshore banking centers, set up as such at the behest of the City of London and Wall Street, Nuland’s sanctimonious remarks have more to do with roping Panama into a regional alliance of “democracies” to advance the globalist Malthusian depopulation agenda using “corruption” as a bludgeon. Money laundering has little to do with it.

In El Salvador, following what was clearly a hostile meeting on June 30 with Bukele, Nuland told reporters, according to *El Mundo* and *La Prensa*

*Gráfica*, that she had warned the President to pay attention to the about to-be-released “Engel List,” because it would name several corrupt individuals in the Northern Triangle of El Salvador, Guatemala, and Honduras, who will be punished under the terms of the Northern Triangle Enhanced Engagement Act, with revocation of U.S. visas, and, among other measures, subjected to Magnitsky Act sanctions. The State Department released that, in fact, today, headlined, “[353 Corrupt and Undemocratic Actors Report](#).” It names, among others, Bukele’s Chief of Staff, his Labor Minister, and Legal Adviser for “undermining democratic processes and institutions.” Legal Adviser Conan Tonathiu Castro Ramírez is charged with “inappropriate removal of five Supreme Court Magistrates and the Attorney General.” The Legislative Assembly carried out that action on May 1, which the Project Democracy apparatus labeled as authoritarian, “undemocratic,” and a coup attempt by Bukele.

Fully aware of who was on the list when she made her warning, Nuland demanded that “every person” named must be “thoroughly investigated,” and that the three nations “take the necessary steps to eliminate corruption from their countries.” Nuland also reported that she ordered Bukele to establish “an independent judicial system, an attorney general and judges elected by a transparent and merit-based process,” in addition to creating an “independent” anti-corruption agency. Nuland also instructed Bukele to “finalize an agreement with the IMF based on the best fiscal practices and needs of future generations.” According to *El Mundo*, Nuland said that the message she transmitted to Bukele “in the name of President Biden and Secretary Blinken was very simple: The U.S. values this relationship but we need in El Salvador the strongest, cleanest and most democratic partner.” It is through respect for the rule of law and democratic principles and institutions, she said, that El Salvador can develop economically and be prosperous.

## NEW WORLD ECONOMIC ORDER

### Russia and United States Planning Joint 9/11 Anniversary Event

July 1 (EIRNS)—The Under-Secretary-General of the United Nations Counter-Terrorism Office and Russia’s former Permanent Representative to UN International Organizations in Vienna Vladimir Voronov issued a statement June 30, that: “On the subject of the 20th anniversary of the September 11 attacks, we are working with our American colleagues to organize an event to commemorate the victims. At our office, the terrorists’ victims are one of the top issues. It is crucial to pay more attention to them and their plight.”

The report in RT includes the following: “In 2005, the Russian government gifted a 10-story sculpture called ‘To the Struggle Against World Terrorism’ by artist Zurab Tsereteli to the United States. Also known as the ‘[Teardrop Memorial](#),’ it is located in New Jersey, and was opened at a ceremony attended by Putin.” Tsereteli’s bronze monument, facing toward where the World Trade Center stood, depicts a jagged rip through the center of the monument in the midst of which hangs a 4-ton nickel teardrop.

The Schiller Institute Chorus has joined with Russian UN representatives, and the Bayonne, N.J. Fire Department in a wreath-laying commemoration at the Teardrop Memorial every Christmas, in memory of the airplane crash off Sochi, Russia, on Dec. 25, 2016 that took the lives of all 92 passengers, including 64 members of Alexandrov Ensemble Choir, known as the Red Army Chorus. They were en route to Syria, to provide aid to the Syrian people, and comfort to Russian troops who would be spending Christmas far from home in the fight against terrorism.

The existence of the Memorial, on the shore of the Hudson River in Bayonne, New Jersey, where people had gathered on 9/11 to watch the horrible event across the river in Manhattan, is virtually unknown to Americans. Perhaps the effort by Mr. Voronov of the UN could lead to a joint U.S.-Russian event at the Memorial, to help inform Americans of the gift and the sentiment from Russia and from President Vladimir Putin, who

said at the laying of the cornerstone, on Sept. 16, 2005, “this monument will always be a testimony for our unity in the struggle against common threats. ... We should never forget that, for all their impressive and grandiose nature, such monuments represent concrete individuals, people who will always live on, not only in stone, not only in monuments, but in our hearts.”

## UNITED STATES POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC

### **U.S. Supreme Court Upholds Arizona Voting Law Restrictions—a Blow Against the Vote Fraud**

July 1 (EIRNS)—The U.S. Supreme Court has voted 6-3 to uphold the new voting law in Arizona, ruling that there is no racist intent. This is a significant blow to the vote-fraud apparatus nationally, which has tried to institutionalize unrestricted mail-in voting and the right for people to gather up absentee ballots and deliver them to the polls. The Democrats in the Congress are even trying to impose it nationally, in contradiction to the Constitution’s explicit placement of voting procedures under the powers of the individual states.

The Court ruled that the two contested issues—that voters must vote in their appointed districts; and that, other than mailmen and election officials, only an official caregiver can deliver the ballot for another, and only for the person in their care—are in no way “racist” or discriminatory.

This will affect similar efforts in 47 other states to take steps against vote fraud. The “big lie” peddled in every news outlet and by the Democrats—that any talk of vote fraud in the 2020 election is a “big lie”—is thus put under closer inspection. The media, of course, call the decision a “blow to voting rights,” apparently believing that minorities are less able to find out where they are supposed to vote, or to vote in person, or to mail in their own absentee ballot.

## Mass Surveillance Targeted at Congressional Hearing

July 1 (EIRNS)—Microsoft Corporate Vice President for Customer Security and Trust [Tom Burt](#) warned the House Judiciary Committee yesterday that government law enforcement now routinely demands secret access to the data stored in the cloud by American citizens, businesses and organizations of all sorts, more often than not using “boilerplate secrecy orders unsupported by any meaningful legal or factual analysis.”

Burt was testifying before a hearing on “Secrecy Orders and Prosecuting Leaks: Potential Legislative Responses to Deter Prosecutorial Abuse of Power,” chaired by Jerrold Nadler. Nadler was concerned about “intrusive” Justice Department investigation under President Trump’s administration of people leaking to the press, but Burt’s testimony made clear that there is no partisan pattern.

“Before the cloud, law enforcement agents executed search warrants and subpoenas seeking someone’s personal correspondence and documents by serving them directly on the people or organizations they wished to search—in other words, the targets received notice,” he said in his written testimony.

Not so now. Many users moved their email, photos and other data to the cloud, expecting greater privacy, “but for citizens, businesses and organizations throughout America, this expectation of privacy is unknowingly misplaced,” Burt testified. “Their own government is secretly demanding users’ data, without their knowledge, from cloud service providers, exploiting a subsection of the 35-year-old Electronic Communications Privacy Act to prevent notification of the demand to users by the cloud service providers. By doing so, the government has transformed decades-old criminal investigative techniques into secret surveillance operations—all without rigorous review by courts. This lack of transparency inevitably leads to overuse and abuse....

“Traditionally, secrecy was the exception. In recent years, law enforcement has turned that exception on its head, developing a practice of reflexively asking to keep even routine investigations secret,” Burt testified.

While the number of secrecy orders Microsoft has been presented has increased, from 2016 to the present —“a period that spans the Obama, Trump, and Biden administrations,” as he pointed out—Microsoft has consistently received between 2,400 to 3,500 secrecy orders each year, or 7-10 per day.

“These are just the demands that Microsoft, just one cloud service provider, received,” he noted. “Multiply those numbers by every technology company that holds or processes data, and you may get a sense of the scope of the government’s overuse of secret surveillance.”

Nor has that pattern lessened: Burt reported that just this week, prosecutors sought a blanket gag order affecting the government of a major U.S. city for their data request to Microsoft, targeting a single employee in the city. “Without reform, abuses will continue to occur and they will occur in the dark,” Burt said.

### **Donald Rumsfeld Is Dead**

July 1 (EIRNS)—Donald Rumsfeld, the man who thought he could transform Iraq into a shining democracy with “shock and awe” bombing and a few special forces troops, died at the age of 88 on June 30. Rumsfeld’s six-and-a-half years as Secretary of Defense under G.W. Bush were nothing short of a disaster. He “transformed” the military into a force capable of failing in two wars at the same time, wars that he helped lie the U.S. into and that he bequeathed to his successors. In the process he turned the “global war on terrorism” into “the long war,” which Donald Trump accurately denounced as “the forever wars.” In February 2006, Lyndon LaRouche ridiculed Rumsfeld’s long war as a fraud. “Long war,” LaRouche said, is not any new theory; it’s imperialism. It’s perpetual war, which the Roman Empire practiced through the deployment of its legions, to destroy the ability of its subject populations to resist, even to resist chaos. It means the continual starting of wars, including by means of “let’s you and him fight,” by which the empire manages its subject populations.

This is no special theory of a new kind of war, or high-tech war, LaRouche continued. “That’s horseshit; in an era when we don’t even have

horse cavalry any more, they're selling horseshit." This is old Roman imperial fascism; the war theory of Nazi fascism.

Rumsfeld resigned in disgrace in November 2006 after the Democrats took back both the House and the Senate from the neo-con Republicans. Rumsfeld's Abu Ghraib torture scandal had a lot to do with the Democratic victories (the tragedy is that the Democrats failed to use the historical opportunity that was handed to them, to stop the march of fascism in the United States, with Nancy Pelosi playing no small role in that intentional failure, but that's another story.)

Rumsfeld never faced the justice he deserved for his crimes while he lived. Perhaps he's facing it now.

### **Trump Organization and Financial Officer Indicted in Continuing Political Witch Hunt**

July 1 (EIRNS)—The long-expected indictment by the political hit squad under Manhattan District Attorney Cyrus Vance, Jr. was served today on the Trump Organization and its financial officer, Allen Weisselberg. Vance has been trying for months to get Weisselberg to “turn” on Trump and help manufacture some crime, as the Justice Department and the Democrats in the Congress have been trying to do for the past five years. Both the Organization and Weisselberg pled not guilty. The “Get Trump” crowd are still cheering for Vance to turn Weisselberg, and in any case to continue the investigation to criminally indict the former President.

The charges are acknowledged by one and all to be thoroughly bogus. The defendants are charged with failing to include \$1.7 million in “percs” for Weisselberg as income and to pay taxes on them. Weisselberg's lawyer said that in his 50 years in practice he had never seen criminal charges for these actions. One may expect his lawyer to say that, but even the CNN in-house legal commentator and the *New York Times* say the same thing. In fact, CNN reported that in most such cases, there is not even civil litigation—the IRS simply informs the target that they must pay taxes on the percs, the taxes are paid, and case closed.

## COLLAPSING WESTERN FINANCIAL SYSTEM

### Renewables Policy Doubling Electricity Prices in Germany

July 1 (EIRNS)—*Handelsblatt*, a German business daily, calls attention to the fact that electricity bills for German industrial companies have doubled since March 2020 to June 2021, from €35/MW-hour to €70/MW-hour. The price is set by free trading at the Leipzig-based EEX energy stock exchange—which treats renewables preferentially against fossil energy sources.

## OTHER

### Australian MPs Join Call for Biden To Free Assange

July 1 (EIRNS)—A cross-party group of 11 Australian Representatives and Senators issued a [video message](#) yesterday directed at President Joe Biden, insisting for him to drop charges against journalist Julian Assange, and imploring the British government to release him from where he is being held in HM Prison Belmarsh against extradition to the United States, and send him home. Assange is an Australian citizen.

In the short video, posted on *Consortium News*, the lawmakers report that they have received a petition signed by over 600,000 Australian citizens urging them to take action to free Assange—one of the largest petitions they have ever received. Each MP added his or her own brief statement on why urgent action is required. The Australian Labor Party appears to have taken the lead here.

### More Genocide Victims Discovered in Canada

July 1 (EIRNS)—Yet another 182 bodies of children buried in unmarked graves near the Catholic Church-run residential schools for the indigenous children in Canada have been found, bringing the total to over 1,000. From the 19th century until the 1970s, more than 150,000 indigenous children were forced to attend state-funded Christian boarding schools, mostly run by the Catholic Church, in an effort to “assimilate them into Canadian society,” AP reports. Some of the schools continued into the 1990s. The

disappearance of the children was exposed in a 1998 report, but the bodies are now being searched for with a technology which identifies bodies underground.

On June 29, it was announced that a group of indigenous leaders will visit the Vatican in December to meet Pope Francis, who is supposed to apologize.

The Canadian government formally apologized for the policy and abuses in 2008. In addition, the Presbyterian, Anglican, and United Churches have apologized for their roles in the abuse.

Twelve church buildings in Canada have been torched in the last 10 days, attacks thought to be arson in retaliation for the genocide.
