EDITORIAL

Russiagate Put to Rest? Time for Action

July 23 (EIRNS)—William Binney, the former technical director at the NSA, today put what should be the final nail in the coffin of the “Russiagate” coup attempt against the democratically elected government of the United States by the British and American intelligence agencies, their controlled and corrupt media, and the equally corrupt Congress. Appearing on an internationally broadcast event—sponsored by the Schiller Institute and *EIR*—Binney, together with his former associate at the NSA Kirk Wiebe and LaRouche PAC analyst Barbara Boyd, demonstrated not only that the entire three-and-a-half-year Russiagate witch hunt was a manufactured hoax, but that it was known to be a hoax from the beginning by its perpetrators. The information presented in the event can and must be the launching pad for the American people, and international supporters of the American experiment, to make this pregnant moment in history the turning point in ending the oligarchical destruction of that experiment in republican government, “of the people, by the people and for the people.”

Binney demonstrated, as he has many times before, that the systems he designed for the NSA to root out terrorists and drug kingpins has been turned against the American people, creating the most massive surveillance system by a state against its own citizens (and in this case around the world) in human history. Boyd pointed to the irony that the Democrats and many of the war-mongers surrounding President Donald Trump, led by Secretary of State Mike Pompeo, are prancing around the world denouncing China as a totalitarian state, while the U.S. itself is functioning as a totalitarian state. Not only is everyone’s entire private life available for view to dozens of U.S. government agencies, but also the nation is now going through a “culture war” in which anyone with even the slightest concern about the Jacobin mobs patrolling our streets is declared an “enemy of the people.” Many Chinese are openly expressing their astonishment that the United States is replaying the nightmare carried out in

China during the last decade of Mao Zedong's life, the "Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution."

All three speakers posed the critical point that the current existential crisis of civilization—the pandemic, the economic collapse, the cultural decay and the extreme danger of war—is also an incredible opportunity, if the patriots of the nation can cut through the induced pessimism that nothing can be done, and commit themselves to take action. Every leader, every candidate for office, must be informed, with passion, that they must stop the coup and join the fight to restore the nation, to bring the world together for cooperation in development in scientific and medical research, in space exploration—in creating a future fit for human existence—or be sent home.

There is a great irony in the fact that Mike Pompeo just visited London, lavishing praise on the U.K.-U.S. "special relationship," taking credit for pressuring the Boris Johnson government in "joining the free world," by cutting off Huawei, and then presenting his disgusting lies about China at the Henry Jackson Society. Why ironic? That society has as a major sponsor, Sir Richard Dearlove, the former MI6 chief who personally ran the "Russiagate" coup attempt against President Donald Trump, together with his MI6 underling Christopher Steele. Add to that Bill Binney's description today of his briefing of Pompeo, at President Trump's request, while Pompeo was still head of the CIA, on the fact that the Obama intelligence team was lying about the Russian hacking of the Democrats' emails. Not only did Pompeo suppress that information, but he then thoroughly endorsed the lies of Clapper, Brennan and Comey about the Russian alleged hack.

Break this truth about the attempted coup everywhere. Free President Trump to do what he intended to do, for which he was elected: End the endless wars, restore the U.S. industrial infrastructure, establish friendly relations with Russia and China. There are no solutions to the many crises facing mankind on a one-at-a-time basis. The British Empire and their U.S. assets are doing everything in their power to prevent the urgent meeting of

Vladimir Putin, Xi Jinping and Donald Trump, even if it means war in this age of thermonuclear weapons. Do not be pessimistic—it is a rare and fleeting moment of opportunity, for those willing to fight, for victory.

STRATEGIC WAR DANGER

Pompeo Argues for the U.S. To End Engagement with China

July 23 (EIRNS)—Secretary of State Mike Pompeo conducted the tail-end of the Four Musketeers, who each presented their China containment speeches over the last few weeks—the others he named were Robert O’Brien, William Barr, and Chris Wray. Pompeo indicated (and it should come as no surprise) that he was the choreographer of this particular vaudeville show, and no doubt this was due to his unique capabilities at West Point where he was the first in his class in “engineering management.” The speech itself was the ultimate “chamber of horrors” description of a world which accepts the P.R.C. Pompeo chose the Richard Nixon Library at Yorba Linda perhaps to highlight that his new China policy was the end of the engagement policy with the People’s Republic of China that began with Nixon’s visit in 1972.

And on that end he was most explicit. “The old paradigm of blind engagement with China simply won’t [work]... We must not continue it and we must not return to it.” He later claimed: “The truth is that our policies—and those of other free nations—resurrected China’s failing economy, only to see Beijing bite the international hands that were feeding it.” And then quoted from Barr’s speech that “ ‘The ultimate ambition of China’s rulers isn’t to trade with the United States. It is to raid the United States.’ ” He droned on and on in the same vein. We were “hoodwinked by Beijing’s talk of a ‘peaceful rise.’ ” And that the CCP runs a Marxist-Leninist regime and “General Secretary Xi Jinping is a true believer in a bankrupt totalitarian ideology.” “When it comes to the CCP, I say we must distrust and verify.” “People’s Liberation Army is not a normal army... Its purpose is to uphold ... the Chinese Communist Party elites and expand a

Chinese empire, not to protect the Chinese people.” ..Communists almost always lie.”

He also urged other nations to come on board his China-bashing bandwagon, calling for a “new alliance of democracies” but expressed some disappointment that not even NATO was terribly interested. “And if we don’t act now, ultimately ... our children’s children may be at the mercy of the Chinese Communist Party,” he lamented. He had some difficulty during the Q&A with the moderator. When asked about the relationship between China and Russia, he just said we have to talk to Russia about arms control, but punted on the implications of the question, i.e., China is not alone. When asked about the importance of personal relationships, like the one between Trump and Xi earlier, he said these are important, but they must produce concrete results. And then the question of how he could attack the CCP and not think he was attacking the Chinese people, he went on about how all individuals are created by God and individuals in China should also have a say in their future. Attending the event were also prominent Chinese dissidents Wang Dan and Wei Jinsheng, so that there were at least two Chinese who paid attention.

After the speech, Pompeo gave an interview to Fox News, in which he repeated the lie, fully disproven, that China “closed down Wuhan to the rest of China but didn’t close down travel to the rest of the world.”

Potential Military Conflict Between Greece and Turkey in the Aegean

July 23 (EIRNS)—The crisis between Greece and Turkey over Turkey’s deployment of a seismic research vessel in waters claimed by Greece as part of its Exclusive Economic Zone continues to play out, with both Greek and Turkish warships in the area. Greek sources warn that an “incident” could occur at any time.

The tension has led to a flurry of diplomatic activity. Greek Prime Minister Kyriakos Mitsotakis held a phone discussion with Russian President Vladimir Putin on July 22, discussing the situation in the Mediterranean, as well as Turkey’s decision to convert the Hagia Sophia museum into a mosque.

Mitsotakis also spoke with German Chancellor Angela Merkel, after the she had spoken with Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan on Tuesday night July 21, in which she urged for de-escalation in the situation.

Following these telephone calls, German Foreign Ministry spokesman Christopher Burger said that Berlin wants a “prudent dialogue,” while pointing out that “progress in EU-Turkey relations is only possible, if Turkey abandons provocations in the Eastern Mediterranean.”

Nonetheless the situation “remained unchanged” in the Eastern Mediterranean region south of the Greek island of Kastellorizo on July 22, after Turkey issued its Navtex on July 21 for seismic research activities in the area, according to a source from the Hellenic National Defense General Staff cited by the Greek daily *Kathimerini*. There are currently an unknown number of both Turkish and Greek naval vessels in the region.

Esper’s Mooted ‘China Visit’ More Hegemonic Bluster, or an Attempt To Communicate?

July 23 (EIRNS)—When Secretary of Defense Mark Esper indicated on July 21 in a video event with the British International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS) that he hoped to visit China “before the end of the year,” it raised some eyebrows in Washington, as well as in Beijing. As far as is known, no invitation has been extended. And there is great uncertainty as to whether such a visit would provide any respite from the intense anti-China campaign being conducted in an almost whole-of-government effort. If Esper were to go to China to “read them the Riot Act,” as he indicated in so many words he might do, one would urge him to stay at home. But if there is an effort to genuinely “establish the necessary crisis communication system” with China, which he also indicated, it could have a positive value.

But the jury remains out at the moment, and whether China will extend such an invitation is no doubt being debated in Beijing. The June 17 Hawaii meeting between Secretary of State Mike Pompeo and Yang Jiechi was a complete wash-out, and it probably could have been predicted that that would be so, given Pompeo’s “messianic” obsession to take down the Chinese Communist Party. But the U.S.-China military-to-military

relationship has maintained itself to a large extent throughout all the ups and downs in U.S.-China relations over the years, given the fact that a cut-off of communications here could quickly lead to misunderstandings and to possible war. And given the intensified “encounters” of both militaries recently in the South China Sea, there may be concerns by both parties that such a visit should occur.

COLLAPSING WESTERN FINANCIAL SYSTEM

Daimler Goes for Deep Cuts in Output and Workforce

July 23 (EIRNS)—Europe Autonews reports that Daimler (Mercedes Benz), the German producer of luxury automobiles, trucks, and buses, wants to cut expenses by 22%, or €2 billion. CEO Ola Källenius made the announcement ahead of a press conference today, which was expected to yield more details about this biggest cost-cutting attempt in the company’s history.

Officially, figures are not available at this writing, but leaks have it that up to 30,000 of the company’s 300,000 jobs globally will be axed. A number of production sites are to be shut down as well, likely including the engine production division at the century-old founding plant in Untertürkheim, near Stuttgart. A week ago, Daimler reported a preliminary second-quarter loss of €1.68 billion (almost \$2 billion) before interest and taxes.

Craig Murray Offered To Testify to Mueller—No Reply

July 23 (EIRNS)—Craig Murray, formerly Britain’s ambassador to Uzbekistan, wrote an email to Ray McGovern, which McGovern shared with correspondent Joe Lauria at *Consortium News* with Murray’s approval, describing how he had written to Robert Mueller, offering to provide evidence to the special counsel’s investigation into Russian election interference, regarding how the emails from the Democratic National Committee (DNC) and John Podesta were delivered to WikiLeaks. “I wrote to Mueller offering to give evidence, never receiving

any reply,” Murray conveyed to McGovern on July 22. “Never had any request for an interview by any U.S. authorities.”

Murray has revealed before that he knows how emails were delivered, by hand, not by hack. Murray also mentioned in an earlier article that Bill Binney had explained to him the means by which he had proven that the emails were downloaded, not hacked.

Murray will be testifying in a trial in Spain against the founder of UC Global, David Morales, who was arrested and is standing trial for the illegal surveillance of WikiLeaks’ founder Julian Assange when he was in the Ecuador Embassy in the U.K., on behalf of the CIA (including privileged Assange-lawyer conversations).

U.S. POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC

Former U.K. Diplomat Murray Promotes Binney Conference, Stands Up to Anti-LaRouche Black Ops

July 23 (EIRNS)—Former British Ambassador Craig Murray, who has been a leading defender of Julian Assange and an acquaintance of Bill Binney, posted a link to the Schiller Institute website broadcast of the press conference today with Binney, and was met by a flurry of attacks on the Schiller Institute. He did not fold, [posting](#) the following note on his website:

“Bill Binney on Russian ‘Hacking’—Live”

“UPDATE—Since posting the link to Bill Binney’s talk, a number of people have been in touch to allege that the hosting organization, the Schiller Institute, has an objectionable right wing or even racist agenda. I am not aware and have no time now to research. I am however 100% certain that Bill Binney, whom I know, is neither right wing nor in any sense racist, and that he has very important things to say. This does not constitute either an endorsement or a condemnation of the Schiller Institute or anybody else who may be present or speaking.

“William Binney, former Technical Director of the National Security Agency (NSA—GCHQ’s much bigger American brother) and the world’s foremost expert in cyber-surveillance, explains why it is impossible that Russia hacked the DNC and Podesta emails for WikiLeaks.

“From the International Schiller Institute, Washington DC live at 11 a.m. in Washington, 4 p.m. in the U.K.”

The responses on this post include a back and forth on Lyn, Helga and the Schiller Institute, some nonsense, some based on Wikipedia (which are not so bad), and some showing some insight. Those who took Murray’s advice and watched the forum will end up far better informed, and hopefully trans-formed as well.

THE NEW GLOBAL ECONOMIC ORDER

China, Ibero-America, Caribbean Nations Step Up Economic and Medical Joint Work in COVID-19 Fight

July 23 (EIRNS)—The headline news from last night’s teleconference among Ibero-American and Caribbean nations and China on COVID-19 cooperation, co-hosted by Mexican Foreign Minister Marcelo Ebrard and Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi, was Foreign Minister Wang’s announcement that the Chinese government will treat any COVID-19 vaccine developed within China as a public good, ensure universal access to it to all countries, and allocate \$1 billion for loans to the Ibero-American and Caribbean nations so they can purchase any such vaccine.

But broader questions of how to mobilize the international cooperation required to face the “greatest world crisis in the last 75 years,” as Ecuadorian Foreign Minister Gallegos put it, were also taken up. The region is now an epicenter of the pandemic, and national health capabilities are being overwhelmed. The urgency of ensuring equitable, universal access to medical supplies, equipment and medicines for all nations was raised by various Foreign Ministers.

Wang presented a list of ways China can help to fight the disease and the economic crisis in the region. They ranged from sending medical personnel and joint work on research/development on vaccines, to promoting allocation of FAO funds to the region for enhancing food security and economic cooperation around the Belt and Road Initiative. Wang said China would make available funds from the \$20 billion in the CELAC Special Lending Program for China-Latin America-Caribbean Infrastructure for building up public health infrastructure in the region. Wang also said that China would continue to increase its trade and investment with the region to help promote the region's economic recovery, importing its products, etc.

The Foreign Ministers of Argentina, Barbados, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Panama, Peru, Trinidad and Tobago, and Uruguay participated. Although Brazil and Bolivia were noticeably absent, the nasty pressures of Pompeo's State Department and Esper's Pentagon on the nations of the region to break with China have failed miserably.

The Foreign Minister of Colombia, which is one of the closest U.S. allies in the region, spoke firmly of Colombia's appreciation of the help they have received from China, their hope that discussions such as this will lay the basis for "a solid relationship of scientific cooperation for the benefit of humanity," and of Colombia's trust that it will be able to "deepen technical, scientific and financial cooperation with the People's Republic of China."

As did many of the Foreign Ministers, Ebrard thanked China for its continuing airlifts of medical equipment and material to his nation for the COVID-19 fight, which he credited to the "high level of political dialogue" between Presidents Xi Jinping and Andrés Manuel López Obrador. It is useful to remember that President López Obrador said months ago that he wished to visit both the United States and China, to personally thank Presidents Donald Trump and Xi Jinping for their help to Mexico in this crisis.

French and Russian Foreign and Defense Ministers Will Meet in 2+2 Conference in Paris

July 23 (EIRNS)—It has been decided that the Russian and French foreign and defense ministers will hold a 2+2 meeting in Paris, although a date has yet to be set. “The ministers will meet in Paris as part of the French-Russian Security Cooperation Council that brings together heads of foreign policy and defense agencies of France and Russia,” TASS was told by diplomatic sources in Paris. On July 16 the political directors of the French Foreign Ministry and the Defense Ministry met with their Russian counterparts in Paris, after which the 2+2 decision was taken.

SCIENCE AND INFRASTRUCTURE

China’s Tianwen Spacecraft Is On Its Way to Mars

July 23 (EIRNS)—China’s first deep space mission, Tianwen, or “Questions to Heaven,” launched from Hainan island this morning at 00:41 Beijing time (08:41 UTC), and has joined the U.A.E.’s Hope (Al Amal) spacecraft on the long journey to Mars. NASA has announced that its Perseverance rover will be launched on July 30. All of the craft should arrive at the Red Planet in February 2021. But what China is planning for Tianwen has never been done before.

Instead of doing a first mission to orbit Mars and then on a subsequent mission deploying a stationary lander, and then a rover, China will do all three on this first mission. (Half of all Mars missions have failed, and only the U.S. has ever succeeded in landing and operating a rover on Mars.)

During China Global Television Network’s “Dialogue” broadcast on the mission today, senior rocket engineer Yang Yuguang was asked, why do all three things at once? He explained that each provides a different view of the planet. “The orbiter gives you an overall, remote sensing view of the planet. You also need more detailed information than you get on the ground. If you can combine all three in to one mission you save money.”

“Is there a race to Mars?” Yang was asked. He replied, “Yes, but today it is driven by scientific competition. And also collaboration, such as with China on the Chang’e series of lunar missions.”

NASA Administrator Jim Bridenstine tweeted: “With today’s launch, China is on its way to join the community of international scientific explorers at Mars. The United States, Europe, Russia, India, and soon the U.A.E. will welcome you to Mars to embark on an exciting year of scientific discovery. Safe travels Tianwen-1!” SpaceX chief Elon Musk also tweeted: “Impressive Tianwen-1 Mars rover mission launched by China today.”

Rail Tunnel for Belgrade-Budapest High-Speed Railway Nearing Completion

July 23 (EIRNS)—The Belgrade-Budapest Cortanovci tunnel, which is part of the double track high-speed rail project being built to link the two cities, is nearing completion, reported to be 91% excavated as of June 10. The boring for the Cortanovci tunnel was begun in 2017. Consisting of two parallel tracks with a length of 2.2 km, the tunnel is being built by the Russian Railways subsidiary RZD International and will permit trains to travel at 200 kph. RZD International has been involved in the modernization of Serbian railways. Serbia recently purchased 27 diesel trains manufactured by Metrowagonmash, founded in Russia in 1897.

The portion of the line between Belgrade and Novi Sad on the Danube should be completed in 2021. The new Novi Sad rail bridge should be opened in September 2020. RZD is enhancing the Stara Pazova-Novı Sad high-speed double-track railway line. Altogether 28 structures are currently under construction, such as galleries, viaducts, pedestrian overpasses, and bridges. RZD is also rebuilding stations.

In 1999, the NATO bombing destroyed eight of Serbia’s bridges on the Danube. The Belgrade-Budapest line is partially financed by China, Russia and the EU, and forms a section of the rail line that eventually goes to Piraeus, Greece.

Elon Musk Invited to Cosmonautics Museum in Russia's Kaluga

July 23 (EIRNS)—Acting Governor of Russia's Kaluga Region Vladislav Shapsha has invited Elon Musk to visit the Tsiolkovsky State Museum of the History of Cosmonautics just south of Moscow, he announced following a meeting with Russian Minister of Culture Olga Lyubimova.

“Kaluga is the homeland of cosmonautics, and many famous people have visited this museum,” the acting governor said. “We welcome everyone who has anything to do with space, and, of course, Elon Musk. We are waiting for him, we invite him to come.”

The director of the museum Natalya Abakumova said Elon Musk often quotes Soviet rocket scientist Konstantin Tsiolkovsky, so he is likely to be interested in visiting the museum.

This follows an invitation by the family of Soviet rocket engineer Sergey Korolev for Musk to visit Moscow, in order to show him historic cosmonautic sights. For his part, Musk invited Korolev's family to visit SpaceX factories and to attend one of the company's next launches.

COVID-19

Medieval Horrors in Bolivia As Coronavirus Spirals Out of Control

July 23 (EIRNS)—Coronavirus in Bolivia is out of control, thanks to the incompetence and cruelty of a neoliberal government for which protection of human life is not a priority. Several Ibero-American dailies this week reported that between July 15 and 20—not even a week—Bolivia's special “anti-crime” unit of the police, picked up 420 cadavers around the country, 85% of whom were presumed to have been infected with COVID-19.

Between April and July, a total of 3,500 cadavers have been picked up—from streets, automobiles and homes, the daily *Infobae* reported. A photo that went viral on the internet was that of a hearse carrying a sign saying that the body of the person inside had been in a private home for several days and was therefore decomposing, *Página 12* reported July 22.

The bodies were retrieved in five different departments (provinces), the largest number in Cochabamba, followed by La Paz. Officially, the country has recorded 64,135 cases, and 2,324 deaths. Virgilio Prieto, National Epidemiology director, told *Infobae* that cases are doubling every week, especially in La Paz and Cochabamba. In western Bolivia, “the situation is going to get much worse because we’re seeing a very rapid escalation,” he reported. He complained that many people are ignoring requirements for social distancing, wearing masks, etc.

More to the point is that the healthcare system has collapsed, and stories abound of people dying at hospital doors, denied entry because there are no beds. President Evo Morales, overthrown in a coup last November, had built up the nation’s healthcare system, increasing the budget by 360%, doubling employment in the sector and building 1,062 new clinics and hospitals. President Jeanine Áñez, who illegally seized power following Morales’ overthrow, and whose government is already embroiled in several corruption scandals, has imposed brutal austerity and authorized mass firings, while failing to provide emergency assistance especially for poorer sectors suffering from the COVID-related economic crisis. More than 70% of Bolivia’s labor force works in the “informal” sector, living hand-to-mouth from street-vending and other unproductive employment. Unemployment has doubled over the past six months.

Interior Minister Arturo Murillo, an overt fascist, lies that “many people are dying out of simple ignorance”—claiming they waited too long before seeking medical care. It is perhaps poetic justice that Murillo, along with Áñez, and five other cabinet ministers, and several deputy ministers have all tested positive for coronavirus.

U.S.-German Effort To Find Vaccine Against COVID-19

July 23 (EIRNS)—Pfizer (U.S.) and BioNtech (Germany) just signed a contract with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services on the delivery of 100 million doses of a vaccine that is being developed by both companies but still has to undergo mass clinical testing. A preliminary test has shown, it is said, that the tentative vaccine has positive effects on

strengthening patients' immunity. Both companies also signed a contract with the British health ministry on the delivery of 30 million doses. BioNtech has a separate, preliminary deal with the German government on the development of a vaccine as well.

OTHER

Labour Making Full Court Press against Boris Johnson, Trump-Style

July 23 (EIRNS)—The British Labour Party has joined full-tilt with the anti-Johnson Tories and, of course, the BBC in an attack on Boris Johnson which smells very much like the Russiagate coup attempt against Donald Trump—and by some of the same players. Labour Party leader Keir Starmer took to the floor of the Parliament yesterday in a rant against Johnson for “badly underestimating the threat from Russia.” “The prime minister received that report 10 months ago. Given that the threat is described as immediate and urgent, why did the prime minister sit on that report for so long?”

This refers to the report released this week by the Parliamentary intelligence committee claiming Russian interference in the 2016 Scottish elections and the Brexit referendum, and other supposed crimes, written by proven liar Christopher Steele and the leaders of the discredited Integrity Initiative, typically devoid of any evidence. It was finished last October, but Johnson held back its release until after the election, saying he didn't want to interfere in the election as Russia is charged with doing.

In fact, as Johnson pointed out in response: “There is nothing in this report, no smoking gun, after all that smoke and fury” over the past year. The report admits in essentially every one of its charges that there is no hard proof.

Johnson did say, however, as Trump does, that he has been very tough on Russia and China.

The BBC, meanwhile, brought on “experts” to say that the report has spurred plans to replace the “Official Secrets Act” with a new espionage act

to clamp down on the nasty Russkis, and to pass a “foreign agent act like that in the U.S.” to keep tabs on the Russian and Chinese press, while also clamping down on social media to stop “Russian disinformation.” Sound familiar?
