EDITORIAL

Legislators of the World, Unite! The Only Way Forward Is Upwards

Oct. 28(EIRNS)—The Second Seminar of current and former legislators of the world deliberated today on the path forward for the nations of the world, out of nuclear confrontation, and toward the sort of mature relations amongst nations, as co-host Helga Zepp-LaRouche, founder of the Schiller Institute, put it, “so that every country realizes its potential.” Her co-host, former Mexican Congresswoman Maria de los Angeles Huerta, spoke from the Chamber of Deputies of the Mexican Congress, from where the seminar was transmitted. Her proposal for the establishment of a global network of “legislators for peace” catalyzed a new level of responsibilities of these former and current national legislators to, as Schiller would put it, go beyond their destinies, in taking on international responsibilities.

In the deliberations, the profound danger of nuclear war was not ignored; rather, it raised the standard required of the participants going forward. One proposal envisioned the necessity of such organizations as the BRICS, ASEAN, the SCO, EAEU, and CELAC rising to the occasion to build an alternative UN, a UN2, with the realistic goal, as Zepp-LaRouche described it, to “overcome poverty for everyone, and organize affairs so that every country realizes its potential.” If present structures were systematically falling short, the idea was to address what was necessary to succeed.

RT, with 30,000 viewers, live-streamed the entire conference. Much was accomplished since the First Seminar only three weeks earlier. Much more needs to be hammered together for the Third Seminar, planned for November 22.

It is hard to overstate the unique effect for legislators from various countries hearing and seeing two genuine American leaders, New York U.S. Senatorial candidate Diane Sare and former Virginia State Senator Richard H. Black, committed to Make America Good Again—living,

breathing Americans of the type that the world had once come to love and admire, when the word “America” was a beautiful sound to the downtrodden and oppressed. What will be the effect on the organizing for the Third Seminar, of Sare’s intervention into the U.S. election over the next twelve days?

Also today, the Valdai Discussion Club met near Moscow, where Russia’s President Vladimir Putin was both brutally candid and fundamentally optimistic, about the greed-obsessed insanity behind the nuclear brinkmanship, but also the fruitful prospects of a multipolar world, with unrealized potentials of countries brought into play. Even the West, Putin offered, would benefit from re-connecting with their creativity!

STRATEGIC SHOWDOWN

Putin Addresses Valdai Plenary, Explains How Multipolarity and Sovereignty Can Even Benefit and Save the West

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—The West and its allies are playing a “dirty game,” where the prize is global dominance, asserted Russia’s President Vladimir Putin, addressing the Valdai Discussion Club, on the theme “A Post-Hegemonic World: Justice and Security for Everyone,” today. As reported by the Kremlin, Putin explained that the U.S. and its allies are not safe from the consequences of their own actions. “Global power is exactly what the so-called West has at stake in its game. But this game is certainly dangerous, bloody and, I would say, dirty.”

The West prohibits other countries from any sort of independence—political, economic or cultural. “In this regard, let me remind you of Russia’s proposals to our Western partners to build confidence

and a collective security system. They were once again tossed in December 2021.

“However, sitting things out can hardly work in the modern world. He who sows the wind will reap the whirlwind, as the saying goes. The crisis has indeed taken on a global dimension and has impacted everyone. There can be no illusions about this.

“Humankind is at a fork in the road: either keep accumulating problems and eventually get crushed under their weight, or work together to find solutions—even imperfect ones, as long as they work—that can make our world a more stable and safer place.

“You know, I have always believed in the power of common sense. Therefore, I am convinced that sooner or later both the new centers of the multipolar international order and the West will have to start a dialogue on an equal footing about a common future for us all, and the sooner the better, of course.”

Having given the West a cold bath of reality, he explained the unappreciated benefits of multipolarity. The West tries to impose their values unilaterally, but that robs everyone, notably including themselves. “First of all, it is the decaying creative potential of the West and a desire to restrain and block the free development of other civilizations.”

One of Putin’s responses in the Q&A to a South African journalist was particularly notable: Asked, given the bankruptcy of the sanctions-regime and of the weaponization of the payments system, isn’t a new economic system on the table? Putin responded: “Your question hit the bulls eye.” He explained: The U.S. created the Bretton Woods system. Now it is failing. The mistake of the U.S. was to use its dollar as a weapon. This has undermined the trust. Everyone is thinking of a way to settle trade in a different fashion.

A new global financial system must allow all countries a chance to engage in sovereign development. We have to respect the choice of pathway of every country. The same goes for the financial system. If we

create new international organizations, as the Bretton Woods system did, they must provide for countries that need help. It will transfer knowledge and technology. The new economic system will meet the interests of the majority, not just the financial elite.

For now, we must expand settlements between countries denominated in national currencies. Since the U.S. is now using the dollar as a weapon, this desire for independence will push forth the use of national currencies. E.g., 53% of Russia's trade with India now is settled in national currencies, and this is growing with other countries. Such arrangements can be used to build an international system that can secure transactions. First nation-to-nation, then regional. I think this building process will continue.

***Politico* Reports, U.S. Accelerates Deployment of Modernized Nuclear Bomb to Europe**

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—The B61-12 nuclear gravity bomb is going into Europe faster than originally planned. This is according to a diplomatic cable seen by *Politico* and two unnamed officials. According to *Politico*, the cable reveals that U.S. officials told NATO allies during a close-door meeting in Brussels this month that the arrival of the upgraded bomb, originally slated for next spring, is now planned for arrival this December. Asked for comment, Pentagon spokesman Brig. Gen. Patrick Ryder responded via email that “while we aren’t going to discuss details of our nuclear arsenal, modernization of U.S. B61 nuclear weapons has been underway for years and plans to safely and responsibly swap out older weapons for the upgraded B61-12 versions is part of a long-planned and scheduled modernization effort.” Ryder claimed: “It is in no way linked to current events in Ukraine and was not sped up in any way.”

The cable, previously undisclosed, was written to be distributed throughout the Pentagon and State Department to give policymakers a rundown of what was discussed at the Oct. 12-13 NATO defense ministerial meeting. It clearly indicates that allies are jittery, *Politico* reports. The document says that during the meetings, 15 NATO allies raised concerns that the alliance “must not give in to Putin’s nuclear

blackmail.” It adds: “Given the rising volume and scale of Russia’s nuclear rhetoric, a subset of allies requested continued consultations at NATO to ensure continued readiness and consistent messaging.”

The B61-12 is modernized from earlier versions of the B61 bomb. Aside from a life extension replacement of components within the nuclear explosive package, the bomb also includes a modified tail kit that gives it far greater accuracy, allowing its variable yield to be dialed back to a maximum of 50 kilotons from the original maximum of 340 kt. This led arms control advocates and anti-nuclear activists to charge that the modifications have made the B61-12 “more usable” as a military weapon.

Nord Stream Investigations: ‘If They Told You, They’d Have To Kill You’

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—In a year when conclusions are trumpeted of every Russian travesty—Bucha, bombings of theaters and maternity wards, threats of nuclear attacks, etc.—with a rush to judgment and complete disdain of evidence, the Sept. 26 sabotage of the Nord Stream 1 and 2 pipelines stand out for their oh-so-careful investigation. Germany has already made clear that they simply can’t divulge any results, as evidently the social fabric could not take it. Sweden won’t even conduct a joint investigation with Germany and Denmark, as their national security would be compromised.

Yesterday, Danish Navy Commander s.g. Jens Wenzel Kristoffersen, told the *New York Times*: “There is a lot of secrecy still going on. The reason is simply because they have to be absolutely sure. When they have results, they have to be based on quite hard-core facts and not just speculation.” There will be no information released from Danish authorities “until they have this smoking-gun evidence.” Anything released before then “could lead to reactions which would not be helpful at this point of time.”

One can only hope that the new religion of not jumping to conclusions and not feeding speculation takes hold in Europe in general. However, the “I could tell you, but then I’d have to kill you” attitude of the Nord Stream

sabotage investigations points in one direction: Western countries are not to bring up certain sensitive subjects that would challenge their masters in London and Washington. That includes the financial derivatives bubble, whether their foreign reserves can be seized, how far their economies and their populations may be savaged by the destruction of supply chains of energy and food, and whether their last lifeline for energy was deliberately targeted and detonated.

UNITED STATES POLITICS AND ECONOMY

Of Pennsylvania Ballots Mailed Out, 20% Are Unverified. Does Law Requiring ID Protect or Disenfranchise Voters?

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—“Here we go again...” begins an Oct. 27 [Zero Hedge](#) article which says that 15 Republicans of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives have [sent a letter](#) to acting Secretary of State Leigh Chapman (D) demanding to know why, as of Oct. 21, there were some 240,000 unverified ballots already mailed out. According to Pennsylvania law, those ballots, if used, “must be set aside and not counted for the 2022 General Election unless the voter produces ID,” as the lawmakers note in their letter. Republicans have thus urged voters to hold onto their mail-in ballots and turn them in to their local board of elections on Election Day, presenting the form of ID specified in the law.

Chapman has countered, arguing that voters would somehow be disenfranchised by appearing in person, although not offering further explanation. She also prepared Pennsylvanians for the expected delays in being able to count all the votes (shades of 2020?), attributing the delays to poll workers not being able to pre-canvas, or to count mail-in ballots prior to Election Day. She makes no mention, of course, of any delay from that flood of unverified ballots, which are a significant portion of the 1.2 million requested mail-in ballots. “So voters and the public know that when there are delays in counting, it doesn’t mean that there’s anything nefarious happening. It’s just what the law is in Pennsylvania,” Chapman said in a

virtual conference, adding it would take “several days” to count and certify the votes.

Chapman characterized the advice for voters to hold onto their mail-in ballots as “misinformation,” and encouraged voters to send those mail-in ballots as soon as possible. She further implied that the “misinformation” was related to reports of unspecified threats aimed at the voting process throughout the state. “She promised that her office has worked to investigate any threat made toward a free and fair election,” according to *Lehigh Valley News*, on Oct. 24.

“Since I’ve been in office in January, we have constantly met with the FBI and Homeland Security just to talk through what the current threat landscape is and tools that we can give our counties to make sure that they have physical security protection as well as cyber security protection,” Chapman said.

Are the 15 Republicans, in insisting upon Pennsylvania voting law on IDs, witting or unwitting agents of foreign influence in U.S. elections? At one time, this would have been considered a ridiculous question. Given Pennsylvania’s role in the shenanigans of 2020, and given both Chapman’s invocation of the term “misinformation” and her reference to meetings with the FBI and Homeland Security, it should be asked whether the notorious Election Security Group is involved. The Election Security Group is composed of the Defense Department’s National Security Agency and U.S. Cyber Command, the FBI, Homeland Security’s Cybersecurity Infrastructure and Security Agency (CISA), and the leading social media and IT platforms of Silicon Valley.

The NSA’s press release about the Election Security Group from Aug. 25 states: “According to the Office of Director of National Intelligence, Russia, China, Iran and other foreign malicious actors may seek to interfere in U.S. voting processes and influence voter perception. Such foreign activity can threaten to undermine fundamental principles of U.S. democracy and influence U.S. public sentiment.”

On cue, a report from private intelligence firm “Recorded Future” released on Oct. 13 said that county election workers in Arizona and Pennsylvania experienced “malicious email activity” in their primaries earlier this year. The report, “[Malign Influence During the 2022 U.S. Midterm Elections](#),” assessed disinformation campaigns from nation-state adversaries—specifically Russia, China, and Iran—and examined “disruptive influence and election security threats from U.S. domestic extremists.”

A Season for Nasty Election Games

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—“We Must Assassinate AOC for America” was a headline for a brief part of today in the [online edition](#) of the *New York Post*—until the *Post* discovered that they had been hacked and then took down that and other crude provocations. In the 12 days before the 2022 elections, such a provocation is designed to generate a reaction and energize a backlash Democratic vote.

And they were provocative. A racist taunt had the Republican candidate for New York governor call New York City Mayor Eric Adams a “fried chicken eating monkey”; an op-ed was headlined, “We Must Murder Joe and Hunter Biden”; another headline had Texas Gov. Greg Abbott say he would “order Border Patrol to start slaughtering illegals.” And those weren’t the worst. At least this little October Surprise involved no false-flag, military stunts—but there are 12 days left.

UKRAINE CRISIS

Russian Mission in Geneva Wants UN Human Rights Commission Move Against the ‘Malicious’ Myrotvorets Hit List

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—The [Russian Mission to the UN](#) and international organizations in Geneva, announced it has sent the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights the open letter of the “[Foundation To Battle Injustice](#),” along with its own endorsement, to take action against Kiev regime’s Myrotvorets hit list. It stated: “The hit list of the Ukrainian nationalists (aka ‘Myrotvorets’) that publishes personal information on the people deemed as

‘enemies of the Kiev regime’ has been endangering the lives of children, journalists and ordinary people since 2014. The Russian Mission to the UN in Geneva has transmitted an open letter from the ‘Foundation to Battle Injustice’ NGO to Volker Türk, the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, regarding the malicious activities of ‘Myrotvorets.’

“The letter, signed by the journalists who are listed on the ‘Myrotvorets’ and receive death threats, and the journalists who wish to stop these flagrant violations of human rights, calls on the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights to condemn the activities of ‘Myrotvorets. The Russian Mission to the UN in Geneva joins this call and urges the High Commissioner to pay special attention, duly assess and publicly react to the existence and operation of ‘Myrotvorets,’ which violates human rights and puts people’s lives in jeopardy,” they conclude.

In April 2015, one sitting Deputy in the Verkhovna Rada and two Ukrainian journalists were murdered after being listed on “Myrotvorets”; on Aug. 20, 2022, the automobile of Russian journalist Darya Dugina exploded in a Moscow street. Myrotvorets blazens the photos of those killed with the word “Liquidated!” in red.

Kiev’s Newest Old Fraud: ‘We Invite IAEA Inspectors To Prove No Dirty Bombs Here’

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—Lost in all the fustian around the lie that Russia’s Defense Minister Sergey Shoigu invented the story on Oct. 23, that Kiev was manufacturing a “dirty bomb,” in a false-flag operation to finish off Russia in the eyes of the world, is that London, Washington and Kiev agreed upon a narrative no later than Sunday evening that could only fool those who wished to be fooled. Their narrative is that Kiev’s innocence will be proven by inviting the International Atomic Energy Agency to inspect Ukraine’s nuclear plants. Complete transparency, complete cooperation. That will prove the Russians are lying, and are probably covering for their own malign intentions to use a nuclear bomb on Ukraine.

Whatever evidence Shoigu presented on Oct. 23 to the defense secretaries of France, Britain, Turkey, and the U.S., part of it is in the

public domain. [RIA Novosti](#) had published that morning that the assembly of Kiev's dirty bomb involved the Skhidnyi Mining and Processing Plant DP in Zhovti Vody. This is in the heart of Ukraine's uranium mining operations from the Soviet period. For building a conventional bomb to include radioactive material that will be dispersed upon the explosion, it helps to have appropriate equipment and machinery that can handle and process such raw material. No nuclear plants were alleged to be involved.

Last night, U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken was still pontificating that Russia's charge is a complete lie: "In fact, the IAEA is now, at Ukraine's invitation, in Ukraine visiting—as they've done in the past—the nuclear facilities that Ukraine has." The chief of Ukraine's Defense Intelligence Gen. Kyrylo Budanov, yesterday chimed in: "We're absolutely supporting the visit of IAEA mission, and we are waiting for them. We're waiting for them to visit all nuclear facilities." He went on that the sooner they arrive, the quicker Ukraine can clear Russia's allegations. Such are only the latest of the week-long recitations.

It may seem bizarre that Kiev would create a radiation-spreading event, but as [Helga Zepp-LaRouche](#) stressed in the conference with elected officials today, "wars are not rational": "Nobody has the right, not NATO, not the military-industrial complex, nor any force in the world to *do what they are doing!* The whole debate about using nuclear weapons, as if that would be a gentlemen's mistake or something, that is *irresponsible!*" She described how the mass media now discuss whether to have tactical nuclear war, or regional nuclear exchanges "as if it were a children's picnic! We have to get people out of this lethargy." As one Caribbean congressman remarked, there is no coverage whatsoever in local media about the war danger, nobody knows the threat to their lives in days, weeks or hours.

Lega Senator Urges New Italian Premier To Use 'Courage,' To Seek European Security Conference, End Ukraine War

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—Italian Sen. Massimiliano Romeo (Lega) said it is not Ukraine alone that decides on the course of the war, referring to NATO's proxy war against Russia in Ukraine. Addressing a presentation by new

Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni, he countered: “It’s a bit harsh to hear you say, ‘the Ukrainians will decide.’ Of course, we should respect the will of Ukrainians, but it would be better to say the international community will decide in the interest of Ukraine,” Euractiv quoted him as saying today.

Romeo assured the Lega party, part of Meloni’s ruling coalition, backs the NATO war in Ukraine, but pushed for the prime minister to have an “act of courage” by seeking for an international conference for defense and security in Europe, with a view for Italy to have an effect on changing “the international geopolitical scenario,” and not unconditionally agreeing to support to Ukraine. “Together with France and Germany, we are among ... those that, in the face of an incessant conflict, risk the most,” Romeo insisted. Such a conference could be an opportunity to set up peace talks, “since now even the United States realizes this may be a road” to take.

Kiev Changes Street Name from Anti-Nazi Liberator to Neo-Nazi Azov Regiment

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—Kiev’s Marshal Malinovsky Street was renamed “Heroes of the Azov Regiment” Street yesterday, with neo-Nazi founder of the Azov Battalion Andrey Biletsky attending the ceremony. Current etiquette demands one look the other way regarding Biletsky’s expressed view that Ukraine had to “lead the white races of the world in a final crusade ... against Semite-led *Untermenschen*,” and that media can only refer to him as a “far-right nationalist.”

By contrast, the ceremony could not have taken place, had not Marshal Radion Malinovsky in April 1944 liberated much of southern Ukraine from Nazi forces, including his home town Odessa. Yesterday, Kiev Mayor Vitaly Klitschko depicted changing the name as “an important step towards reducing the deceitful manipulations and influence of the Russian aggressor on the interpretation of our history.” In February 2014, former boxing star Klitschko was U.S. Ambassador Geoffrey Pyatt’s favorite to be post-coup prime minister; he was overruled by Victoria Nuland, who insisted on imposing Arseniy Yatsenyuk.

Canadian Schiller Institute Member Discusses on CCTV How China Defends Human Rights by Wiping Out Poverty

Oct. 27 (EIRNS)—On Oct. 24, the program Network News Broadcast on [China Central Television](#) (CCTV) aired a two-minute, Chinese-language news story, entitled “International Voices: 20th CPC National Congress Promotes World Peace and Development,” featuring brief excerpts from interviews with various international experts. The first speakers featured former Philippines President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo; Francesco Maringò, President of the Italy-China Promotion Association of the New Silk Road; and Suos Yara, First Vice Chairman of the Central Committee of Foreign Affairs of the Cambodian People’s Party. All expressed in various ways their appreciation for the global leadership role which China is playing in the world—as one put it—at a time of great tensions, such as in Ukraine and the Taiwan Strait, you show how to renew peaceful economic growth. Another stressed the importance of China’s Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) and Global Security Initiative.

The [video](#) ended with a 20-second clip of “the Schiller Institute expert in Canada,” Robert Hux who said: “President Xi Jinping is right when he said in his report to the 20th National Congress report that the world is going through unprecedented changes that require a renewed commitment to peace and development. And over the last decade, China has become the most essential factor of stability in the strategic situation. Since China proposed the Belt and Road Initiative in 2013, developing countries have a well-founded hope of overcoming poverty and underdevelopment. And since poverty is one of the most severe human rights violations, China must be recognized as having contributed more to protecting human rights than any other country on the planet.”
