Reject the Zelenskyy Hollywood Showtime; Organize Support for Peace Conference

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—Schiller Institute founder and leader [Helga Zepp-LaRouche](#) used a pre-Christmas webcast today to urge for an expanded

mobilization behind the offer of Pope Francis to use the Vatican as a site for negotiations between Russia and Ukraine, without preconditions, to end NATO's war against Russia.

Every thinking person, she said, is concerned with the danger of an escalation to World War III. She urged viewers to circulate the [Schiller Institute's letter of support](#) for the Pope's offer, in the spirit of Christmas, and use the season as a moment for serious reflection on the mission of Jesus to achieve peace, through acting with good will towards all men.

The Zelenskyy extravaganza in Washington on Dec. 21 demonstrated the opposite approach, exposing the British intent for expanding the war, even as NATO is approaching to cross the trip-wire of what is unacceptable to Russia. The Zelenskyy in-person speeches, along with the U.S. intent to forward-place Patriot missiles, is an escalation of the nuclear war danger.

Zepp-LaRouche said that she believes the war hawks, typified in Germany by the Green officials in the government, are also preparing an escalation against China in 2023. But if they are successful in "diversifying" the European Union economies away from China, Europe will be "marginalized."

Instead, the potential still exists for Europe to participate in the great global Belt and Road Initiative. Zepp-LaRouche cut to the core on this potential in two other media events she did today. In a nine-minute video statement, "[German Expert: The Biggest Threat to Human Rights,](#)" broadcast by China's television network CGTN, today, she stressed that the right to development—economically and in all other ways—is a fundamental right. In fact, the greatest violation of human rights is denying people the right to develop! Nations of the Global South are attempting to create a New Paradigm, serving the principle of development, in which the Belt and Road Initiative, the BRICS-Plus, Shanghai Cooperation Organization, Eurasian Economic Union, and China's Global Development Initiative all figure.

Downturn,” in which the daily’s staff interviewed specialists, including Zepp-LaRouche. Zepp-LaRouche warned that the “world’s financial system will continue facing major issues, such as heightened inflation. That means the central banks of major development economics will vacillate between efforts to contain inflation through quantitative tightening, which risks bankruptcies and capital flight out of the emergency markets, and quantitative easing, which again increases inflation. Any country that looks to dilute the combined effect should scale up BRI cooperation.”

On the immediate war threat, compatriots of Zepp-LaRouche are using their pre-Christmas message to sound the alarm, some formally linked to the letter of support to Pope Francis for offering a negotiations venue, and some others acting in parallel.

In eastern Germany, Karl Krökel, a skilled trades master, is commanding local media coverage to urge “writing to Pope Francis” in support the Holy Father’s initiative.

In Italy, on Dec. 21, Cardinal Matteo Zuppi, who heads up the Italian Bishops’ Conference, spoke in Bari, at the Basilica of Saint Nicholas, at a vigil organized by the Italian Bishops and by the Archdiocese of Bari-Bitonto, to call for an end to violence in Ukraine. Cardinal Zuppi urged the convening of a conference “like Helsinki, that could resolve many conflicts and lay the basis for peaceful coexistence.” He said that Saint Nicholas “doesn’t want violence and orders peace! Italian Cardinal Zuppi Adds to Calls for a 'Helsinki' Conference for Peace in Ukraine

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—As reported by Vatican News today, at the Basilica of Saint Nicholas in Bari, in southern Italy, [Cardinal Matteo Zuppi](#), president of the Italian Bishops Conference, spoke yesterday at a vigil organized by the Conference and the Archdiocese of Bari-Bitonto to call for an end to violence in Ukraine. He urged that a conference be convened, “like Helsinki, that could resolve many conflicts and lay the basis for peaceful coexistence.”

Saint Nicholas, he said, “doesn’t want violence and orders peace! Let no one say that the conditions don’t exist. They can be found! Enough of combat that only leads to destruction! Peace isn’t a dream, it’s the only way to live. It is ‘the’ choice, not ‘a’ choice.

In his homily, he called for a Christmas truce, as Secretary of State Cardinal Pietro Parolin had, and for a commitment to organize “a conference which, as so wisely took place in Helsinki too many years ago, can resolve so many conflicts and create the bases for peaceful coexistence.”

The [Basilica of Saint Nicholas](#) was an appropriate site for Cardinal Zuppi’s call for peace, as it is an ecumenical center which attracts pilgrims from many different religions, including Orthodox Christians. In 1966, at one end of the crypt which holds the relics of Saint Nicholas, an Orthodox chapel was built, but the Dominican friars who live in a community at the Basilica, maintain the vision that Saint Nicholas is everyone’s saint who brings together Christians of many different expressions from East and West.

In 2018, Pope Francis invited religious leaders from all the Middle Eastern denominations to meet at Bari to pray for peace in the Middle East and peace in Syria. Bari was chosen because it represents a “window into the East” and because it is home to the relics of Saint Nicholas, who is venerated by Christians of the East and West alike.

Dmitry Medvedev in Beijing for High-Level Meetings with President Xi Jinping and Top Officials

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—Dmitry Medvedev, Deputy Chairman of the Russian Security Council and chairman of the United Russia party, was welcomed in Beijing on Dec. 20-21, responding to an invitation from the Chinese Communist Party, Xinhua reported.

This news service had previously reported unconfirmed reports that Presidents Xi and Putin were going to meet before the end of the year, which seems unlikely to happen. When Medvedev met with Xi on Dec. 21, he delivered a personal letter from Putin. TASS quoted a statement from his office that Medvedev “delivered a message from Russian President Putin to the Chinese head of state which particularly noted the unprecedented level of Russian-Chinese political dialogue and practical cooperation and expressed confidence in unfailing gradual development of interstate and interparty ties....

“The two sides synchronized their watches on a number of significant international issues, highlighting the fact that Moscow’s and Beijing’s approaches to the most pressing global problems largely coincide, and touched on the issue of strategic foreign policy coordination, especially within the UN framework and at other multilateral venues, including the SCO, BRICS and the G20. The situation in the post-Soviet region, including the Ukrainian crisis, was discussed.”

Medvedev’s meeting with Xi also included Foreign Minister Wang Yi and other top officials. Xi reportedly handed Medvedev a letter for Putin.

Beijing’s Foreign Ministry pointed to Xi’s statement that China is prepared to work with Russia to push Russia-China relations into “the new

era and make global governance more fair and equitable.” On the Ukraine conflict, Xi said that “China has always decided its position and policy on the merits of the issue itself, and has taken an objective and fair position and actively promoted peace talks. He expressed the hope that relevant parties will remain rational and exercise restraint, engage in comprehensive dialogue, and address their common security concerns through political means.”

United Russia issued a statement following the meeting saying that “fruitful Russian-Chinese talks in Beijing proved to be an important milestone in terms of joint efforts to strengthen dialogue between United Russia and the Chinese Communist Party, and relations between the two countries in general,” TASS reported. The delegation with Medvedev included the United Russia party’s general council, First Deputy Speaker of the Federation Council Andrey Turchak, and Vladimir Vasilyev, United Russia’s faction leader in the State Duma.

Ibero-America Looks to Belt and Road, China’s Development

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—Pressure as they have, U.S. diplomats and military officers have not succeeded in turning Ibero-America and Caribbean against China and its Belt and Road Initiative.

More than 300 Ibero-American, Caribbean, and Chinese businessmen, representing some 150 companies, participated in the 25th annual China-LAC Businessmen’s Summit on Dec. 14-15. Co-sponsored by China’s International Trade Promotion Council and the Ecuadorian Ministry of Production, Foreign Trade, Investment and Fishing, the hybrid in-person/online summit was opened by President Guillermo Lasso—a conservative former banker who professes support for NATO and was visiting Biden at the White House on Dec. 19—by describing the Latin America-Caribbean (LAC) region, with its 662 million inhabitants, as “very interconnected with the People’s Republic of China.”

The “Guayaquil Initiative” statement, issued at the end of the summit, endorsed the Belt and Road Initiative as key to fostering interconnectivity, which in turn unleashes development potential, for everyone’s “mutual

benefit and win-win.” Scientific and technological R&D and “innovation” were also cited as key areas for cooperation.

Earlier in the week, Mexican legislators, academics and media had participated in Xinhua’s Dec. 12 conference in Mexico City, titled “New Opportunities for the World through China’s New Development: Chinese Modernization and China-Latin American Relations.” The chair of the Mexican Chamber of Deputies’ Mexico-China Friendship Group Deputy Yeidckol Polevnsky praised China’s fight to eradicate poverty and raise the quality of the life of their people. The Chinese dream “is the invigoration of the country in order to bring about its people’s happiness. That is easy to say, but it has a formidable background.” Mexico has much to learn and apply from China’s efforts to create a modestly prosperous society and socialism with Chinese characteristics, she stressed.

Polevnsky reportedly spoke of plans for the Chamber of Deputies to have China’s achievements become better known in Mexico. “We want to widely publicize how much China has achieved, and above all, the principles and values on which the Belt and Road is based which are ... respect [and] cooperation for development without requiring conditions from you.”

STRATEGIC SHOWDOWN

Putin Addresses Defense Ministry Board, Says Russia Will Continue Upgrading Its Nuclear Forces

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—Russian President [Vladimir Putin](#), in an address to an expanded meeting of the Russian Defense Ministry board yesterday, promised that Russia will continue to modernize and upgrade its strategic nuclear forces. “It is the main guarantee that our sovereignty and territorial integrity, strategic parity and the general balance of forces in the world are preserved,” he said.

“This year, the level of modern armaments in the strategic nuclear forces has already exceeded 91%. We continue rearming the regiments of our strategic missile forces with modern missile systems with Avangard

hypersonic warheads,” Putin continued. He reported that “in the near future,” the Sarmat heavy ICBM will be on combat duty for the first time, and that combat units are continuing to be re-equipped with the Yars solid fuel ICBM. Putin also stated that the Russian Navy frigate *Admiral Gorshkov* will go on combat duty in early January equipped with Tsircon (Zircon) hypersonic missiles. He vowed, “We will continue equipping our strategic forces with the latest weapon systems.”

Moscow’s Ambassador Antonov Considers That Neither Ukraine nor U.S. Is Ready for Peace

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—In response to a media query, posted to the Russian Embassy’s website, Russian Ambassador to the U.S. [Anatoly Antonov](#) said Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy’s visit to Washington Dec. 21 has demonstrated that neither Ukraine nor the U.S. is ready for peace. “The theses appearing in the American media that Russia is not interested in achieving peace are false,” he said, adding that Moscow’s position had been repeatedly voiced by the Russian President.

“The head of the Kiev regime’s visit to Washington, staged in Hollywood style, has ultimately confirmed that the administration’s conciliatory statements about the lack of intention to enter into a confrontation with Russia are an ‘empty phrase,’ ” Antonov commented. Referring to the U.S. decision to send a Patriot battery to Ukraine, he said: “The provocative actions by the U.S. are steadily leading to an escalation, the consequences of which cannot even be imagined,” the Ambassador warned.

“What was essentially announced to applauses and sarcastic smirks, was the need to continue the ‘proxy war’ against our country. Till a full victory over us,” Antonov opened his response, and saying “Enormous resources, weapons, intelligence capabilities are thrown in. The manic idea of ‘victory over the Russians on the battlefield’ is put at the forefront. Some legislators even argue that the Russian Federation can be conquered in three days.”

As for the U.S. decision to send Patriot missiles to Ukraine, Antonov continued: “Despite our warnings, Patriot air defense system will be sent to

Kiev. However, the country does not have specialists to work with them. So, will those be American specialists? Or citizens of another NATO country? They cannot but realize here [in Washington] that Western weapons are being systematically destroyed by our military. I think everyone understands perfectly well what fate the personnel manning these complexes on the territory of Ukraine, can face.

Will One Patriot Battery Make a Difference in Ukraine?

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—Yesterday, President Joe Biden, with the deluded Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy at his side, announced that the latest weapons package that the U.S. will provide to Ukraine will include one Patriot air defense/anti-missile battery, along with an unspecified amount of missile ammunition. There is good reason, however, to question whether this single battery will make a difference on the battlefield of Ukraine.

A senior defense official told reporters at the Pentagon, “Our goal is to help Ukraine strengthen a layered, integrated approach to air defense.” He also said that it would work together with other, shorter-range air defense systems that the West has already provided to Ukraine. However, “Patriot does require training, and we expect it will take several months to ensure Ukrainian forces have the training they need to employ it successfully.” A single Patriot battery includes 6-8 launchers, a radar unit and a command-and-control section, along with support functions to include power and maintenance. It takes 90-100 troops to run a single Patriot battery, which is a technologically complex system. The senior defense official reported that “the Ukrainians will have to complete the training in order to be able to, you know, field the system. And it’s the Ukrainians who are operating the system, so that’s absolutely essential.”

The second problem relates to how much of an area can a single Patriot battery even cover, despite its capabilities against distant targets? Ukraine is getting one Patriot battery, but in 2013, NATO deployed *six* Patriot batteries to defend a NATO radar and two air bases in an area much smaller than Ukraine against threats allegedly stemming from Syria and Iran. While the Patriot can engage manned aircraft up to a range of 160 km, it can engage tactical ballistic missiles out to a range of 30 km, meaning that the area it can defend is very limited. As the Russians know well, a Patriot battery is also a soft target, meaning it can be easily destroyed. The Patriot system is also limited by the fact that its radar can only cover 120° of the horizon, which means that if the threat comes from a different direction than where it is facing, it can't see it. "In the kind of environment we're seeing in Ukraine, where threats can come in from multiple directions, you either have to have more radars or more batteries," Ian Williams of the Missile Defense Project at the Center for Strategic and International Studies in Washington told Agence France-Presse on Dec. 15.

Russian Embassy in Washington Insists Nord Stream Will Not Be 'Swept Under the Carpet'

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—The [Russian Embassy in Washington](#) issued a statement on its website on Dec. 21 declaring that Russia will not allow the truth about sabotaged the two Nord Stream submarine pipelines in the Baltic Sea to be "swept under the carpet."

"We took notice of the *Washington Post* investigation of the terrorist attack on the Nord Stream international gas pipelines. The journalists—unlike the local authorities, who 'suddenly' abandoned megaphone diplomacy and speculations in their favorite 'highly likely' style—are trying to get to the truth about the unprecedented attack on the pipeline infrastructure that took place in the Baltic Sea. We cannot but welcome such an aspiration," the Embassy statement reads.

"We emphasize that our country will not allow the inconvenient truth about what happened to the Nord Stream to be 'swept under the carpet'....

We will continue to insist on a comprehensive and transparent investigation with Russian participation,” it concludes.

Referring to unnamed sources, the *Washington Post*'s Dec. 21 article said, “A handful of officials expressed regret that so many world leaders pointed the finger at Moscow without considering other countries, as well as extremist groups, that might have the capability and the motive to conduct the attack.”

The Infamous CCD Hit List Is Back

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—NATO's “information warfare” unit within Ukraine's National Security and Defense Council, the [Center for Countering Disinformation](#) (CCD), once again posted, on Dec. 20, a list of Western figures who, it charges, promote Russian propaganda. Number one on the list, still, is Helga Zepp-LaRouche, founder and head of the international Schiller Institute.

As documented in *EIR*'s exposé in the Sept. 2, 2022 issue, the CCD blacklist is a hit list, which overlaps and is coordinated with the notorious Myrotvoret's assassination list. The CCD puts speakers on its hit list for such “crimes” as publicly advocating a peaceful settlement to the Russia-Ukraine conflict, pointing to NATO's role in provoking that war, or merely asserting that Russia, and Russian culture, have a right to exist. The CCD demands every chance it gets that governments designate people holding such views as “information terrorists,” to be tried as terrorists.

This is the third time the CCD has posted such a list. The first appeared on July 14. That list named 71 people, with Zepp-LaRouche and the first 30-odd speakers at various Schiller Institute international conferences right up front. Feeling the heat of the Schiller Institute's international campaign against its hit list, and diplomatic pressure from certain governments, the CCD removed the list on August 11. The CCD then re-posted the list in early October, adding a couple dozen more people to those previously named to bring the total to over 90. In the midst of another flurry of negative attention to its hit list, particularly from within Germany, the list was then removed again on the weekend of Nov. 6.

Now the list is back, shortened to some 40 people, for whatever reason, and accompanied by a CYA statement that “it should be noted that the listed persons are not Russian propagandists, but promote narratives consistent with Russian propaganda.”

List or no list, at no time has NATO’s CCD stopped targeting “Russian propagandists” in the West on its Telegram channel, or stopped its campaign for a war against “information terrorists.”

U.S. POLITICAL & ECONOMIC

Zelenskyy and Biden Seem Not To Be on the Same Wavelength

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—During their Dec. 21 visit at the White House, after being promised another \$1.85 billion by President Joe Biden, Ukrainian President [Volodymyr Zelenskyy](#) at times appeared to be speaking from a different script than Biden’s, despite the latter’s insistence that the U.S. would back Ukraine for “as long as it takes” amidst much backslapping and protestations of admiration.

During their joint press conference, while Biden also asserted that Zelenskyy was “open to a just peace,” Zelenskyy stated a few minutes later that, “So there can’t be any just peace in the war that was imposed on us by these ... these ‘inhumans’ ”—an open admission of the Kiev Nazis’ conception of the Russians as *untermenschen*. He added that for him, “just peace [means] no compromises,” and “the payback for all the damages inflicted by Russian aggression.”

This contradiction must have raised a few eyebrows, because some hours later the website of the [Ukrainian Presidency](#) ran a statement claiming that Zelenskyy had discussed his so-called 10-point peace plan with Biden, which was first presented at the [G20](#) meeting in Bali; calling it a “peace formula” is stretching things. In his speech to Congress, Zelenskyy said he had discussed this 10-point plan with Biden and that the U.S. President had “agreed with it,” although the White House had no public report on the contents of the plan.

Some analysts pointed out that Zelenskyy would not have personally traveled to Washington, had there not been some signal of a shift in bilateral relations. The U.S. decision to send a Patriot missile system reportedly signalled that positive shift. But Zelenskyy was adamant that \$1.85 billion and the Patriot missiles offered were not enough. “We would like to get more Patriot missiles,” he said, arguing that all these weapons and aid “were not charity” but in fact an “investment” in global security. But, as one CNN analyst noted, beneath all the mutual praise, there were tensions. Biden hasn’t always been comfortable with Zelenskyy’s constant demand for more and more weapons and other aid, particularly with a more vocal Republican House questioning these decisions and an American public increasingly opposed to financing Ukraine.

When asked by a reporter whether he had calculated whether sending a Patriot missile system to Ukraine could be considered “escalatory” by Putin, Biden insisted it was not, because “it’s a defensive system ... it’s not escalatory, it’s defensive. One Ukrainian journalist then asked why the U.S. couldn’t just send the Patriots and everything else that Zelenskyy is asking for—“all capabilities, including long-range missiles, ATACMS, to liberate all territories as soon as possible?”

Earlier in the press conference Biden had boasted that Putin had failed in his efforts to break up NATO and the EU. NATO today is “more unified than ever,” he proclaimed, as are the European nations. But in response to that reporter’s question, he said there are two reasons why the U.S. can’t give Ukraine everything there is to give. One is that “there’s an entire Alliance that is critical to stay with Ukraine. And the idea that we would give Ukraine material that is fundamentally different than what is already going there would have a prospect of breaking up NATO and breaking up the European Union and the rest of the world.” (Are NATO and the EU so fragile?) Of course, he said, the U.S. will give Ukraine what it needs “to be able to defend itself, to be able to succeed and succeed on the battlefield.”

The other issue, he explained, concerns the European allies and heads of states, whom Biden has tried to convince that it is “overwhelmingly in their

interest that they continue to support Ukraine. They understand it fully,” he said. But, “they’re not looking to go to war with Russia. They’re not looking for a Third World War. And I think it can all be avoided by making sure that Ukraine is able to succeed on the battlefield. So anyway, there’s more to say, but I probably already said too much.”

COLLAPSING WESTERN SYSTEM

Qatargate’s U.S. Connection, the Human Rights Mafia

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—The Qatargate scandal now rocking the European Union has a U.S. connection through the New York City-based Human Rights Foundation. This organization financed the Fight Impunity NGO which was used to “keeping the money moving” by the conspirators headed by former Member of the European Parliament Antonio Panzeri. According to Wikipedia, HRF was founded by Thor Halvorssen Mendoza in 2005 and has been carrying out campaigns against Russia, China and other countries. It has organized a “global conference series” called the Oslo Freedom Forum. While Mendoza is the organization’s CEO, its chairman is Russian chess grandmaster Garry Kasparov, top hater of Russian President Putin. Javier El-Hage is HRF’s chief legal officer, who has appeared in conferences sponsored by Fight Impunity in the European Parliament.

According to its filings in 2021 it had over \$21 million in revenue. Donors include Democratic National Committee Treasurer Andrew Tobias, Bill Browder, who is responsible for the anti-Russian Magnitsky Act, blockchain innovator Brock Pierce, and the infamous Peter Thiel. HRF has also received funds from foundations including the Arcus Foundation, who state in their mission “We partner with experts and advocates for change to ensure that LGBTQ people and our fellow apes thrive in a world where social and environmental justice are a reality”; the Sarah Scaife Foundation, the Foundation for Democracy in Russia, linked to Kasparov, the neo-conservative Bradley Foundation. HRF’s page donation page says you can donate in cash or Bitcoin, but the latter page returns a 404 error.

The EU Backs Gas Price Cap, in the Footsteps of Diocletian

Dec. 22 (EIRNS)—While the man on the street thinks that the “Price Cap” imposed by the EU on the gas price will reduce prices, “it is a further example of how people are being cheated by politics,” Italian economist Michele Geraci tweeted. “The Price Cap on gas, fixed at the highest value between €180 and the price of other markets (for instance LNG) plus €35, is just the maximum price for trading on the TTF. OTC transactions instead, will have no limit.”

Even the EU regulator has cast doubts on the Price Cap, the *Financial Times* reported.

“The EU’s energy regulator has warned that the bloc’s new gas price cap was unlikely to lower costs for consumers or businesses if countries kept on rushing to fill their depleted reserves, calling the mechanism agreed by ministers this week ‘unprecedented, untested.’ Christian Zinglensen, director of the EU’s joint energy agency Acer, said he would be ‘reluctant to rely on this gas price cap’ alone to prevent the types of price spikes that roiled Europe’s energy markets in the summer following Russia’s invasion of Ukraine.”

Apparently, those who pushed the Price Cap (former Italian Prime Minister Mario Draghi is credited with the original idea) not only do not know economics, they do not even know history.

The first historically recorded price cap was introduced by Roman Emperor Diocletian in 301 AD. It was imposed on a broad category of goods in the attempt to control inflation which had been generated by money printing and made the situation worse.

Even the ever unreliable Wikipedia reports: “The edict did not solve the problem, as the total mass of coins minted continued to increase inflation and the maximum prices that were set were apparently too low. Merchants either stopped producing the goods, sold them illegally on the black market (which proliferated in those years), or used the barter system instead. The edict as a result prompted the cessation of business and trade, either between merchants or in whole cities, which were no longer able to

produce the goods at acceptable costs. Since the edict also had set limits on wages, those who had fixed wages (particularly soldiers) found that their wages had increased but were no longer valuable because artificial prices did not reflect real costs. Thus a real paralysis of the economy in the empire was produced.”

Incidentally, Diocletian also attempted to implement a Final Solution for Christians. The EU has more than one similarity with him.
