Fighting the Stolen American Election, ‘Think of the World’

Nov. 30 (EIRNS)—Pennsylvania legislators struggled through the day Monday, Nov. 30, to pass an action to take back constitutional control of elector selection resulting from a state election unlawfully run and distorted by fraud, while state legislators in Arizona gathered plenty of mail-ballot fraud evidence to do the same at an all-day hearing in Phoenix.

Demonstrations occurred at both state houses, and in the Pennsylvania legislature, calls were reported coming in at 25,000/day, demanding that the GOP legislators stick to their guns and take action.

The Pennsylvania fight, at this moment, is not only setting a leading example for other states' legislatures catching up to it. It is an *internationally* crucial flank in President Donald Trump's ability to defeat a coup, and for ending elections rigged by "secret government" forces with British intelligence connections like the Malloch-Brown/Soros International Crisis Group, GCHQ, and the "Five Eyes." The legislative resolution to take back the naming of electors is thoroughly grounded on both the U.S. Constitution—which gives "time, place, and manner" of elections solely to state legislatures unless Congress overrules them nationally. It defends the Pennsylvania Constitution, which grants them sole authority to prescribe regulations for elections—regulations unilaterally changed in this year of "election deregulation" by state executives, in order to facilitate voting by mail *en masse* with no rules. And the legislators' resolution is matched by a lawsuit by State Rep. Michael Kelly, affirming the same constitution, against the same violations, and on which two court instances in the state have ruled opposite to each other. If the U.S. Supreme Court does not agree to hear this textbook case tailor-made for it, we must suspect unlawful intimidation of justices.

The sovereignty of U.S. federal states is firmly bounded by the constitutional sovereignty of the United States government, and Donald Trump through his presidency has battled to assert those against more than four years' continuous attempts instigated from London to destroy him politically or by coup. He has fought particularly against the supranational economic suicide pact called the Paris Climate Accord, and its "COVID" mutations, the World Economic Forum's "Great Reset" and the Green New Deal. He has up to now faced down the attempts by the Federal Reserve Bank governors to join world central banks in seizing fiscal control from governments and forcing investments into backward technological throwbacks, so-called "green" power sources and the like.

This fight by Trump involves the entire world. Just look at South Africa, a country vital to development of a vast continent: It is being bullied by international investors pulling out of coal, to plan closing down 20% of its already inadequate electric power capacity and shove its economy back to total underdevelopment. This is the green, new—and as old as empire—London/Wall Street deal.

Moreover: Defeating COVID by worldwide vaccination campaigns in 2021 depends on the cooperation with China and Russia which was President Trump’s intention when elected, publicly restated by him many times until driven from it by a rigged election campaign. Increasing food production and distribution worldwide, to stop clear signs of spreading “pandemic famine,” demands from at least the United States, China, and the same great power cooperation.

The world needs a sovereign United States committed to “great projects”—from hospital building to river basin development to space travel—in cooperation with other great sovereign powers.

Therein lies the fight to end elections run by “secret government” and “surveillance state” agencies claiming to guarantee election security (against Russians!) and ordering state governments to buy just certain voting machines.... Right now certain state legislatures have the lead in this battle, and they need mass support.

But view the turning-point hearings this past Saturday, Nov. 28, of the Schiller Institute’s “[International Investigative Commission on Truth in Elections](#),” to see clearly the whole context for this fight to end rigged elections everywhere. And think of the world!

Tony Blinken/Michèle Flournoy Firm Supplying Obama Alumni To Make Up a Biden ‘Government’

Nov. 30 (EIRNS)—In its Nov. 23 issue, *Politico* published a detailed profile of WestExec Advisors, the consulting firm founded in 2017 by Joe Biden’s Secretary of State-designate Tony Blinken and Defense Secretary hopeful Michèle Flournoy, under the headline “[The Secretive Consulting](#)

Firm That's Become Biden's Cabinet in Waiting." The company, which describes itself as "a diverse group of senior national security professionals with the most recent experience at the highest levels of the U.S. government," is in fact now "lending" a portion of its personnel—almost all of whom are alumni of the Obama Administration—to Biden, to serve in various advisory roles, if not already chosen to fill posts in what he hopes will be his presidency. And, that presidency would without doubt be "Obama-3."

Without exception, every single one of the company's principals, as described on its website, has held a leading post at the White House, the State Department, Treasury, National Security Agency, the CIA, National Security Council, as well as in the military—under Obama. Now, five WestExec staffers are currently on leave from the firm to help "staff Biden's review teams for the Pentagon, the Treasury Department, the Council of Economic Advisers and other agencies," *Politico* reported. A former principal is Avril Haines, Biden's choice for Director of National Intelligence. Presumably, when Blinken and Flournoy founded the firm in 2017, they were confident that Trump would be defeated in 2020. WestExec was so prepared to "storm a new Democratic West Wing," *Politico* explains, that it negotiated a clause when renting its office space that states it can break the lease "if members are called back to public service," as reported by the *American Prospect* this month.

Politico points out that the firm's website shows a map depicting West Executive Avenue, which is the secure road on White House grounds between the West Wing and the Eisenhower Executive Office Building, and then brags, "it is quite literally, the road to the Situation Room, and it is the road everyone associated with WestExec Advisors has crossed many times *en route* to meetings of the highest national security consequences."

As for WestExec's secretive nature, no one knows anything about its client list; staffers aren't lobbyists, so they don't have to disclose whom they work for. When Flournoy was recently asked how WestExec Advisors might influence a Biden Administration, she coyly replied that the firm is

not a “purely” Democratic outfit, naming two Republicans, one from the Bush Administration, one from Trump’s, who work there. She also mentioned West Exec’s work with Silicon Valley start-ups “to land contracts at the Pentagon.” Both WestExec and the Biden transition team declined to provide any additional information on the identity of the firm’s clients.

STRATEGIC WAR DANGER

Iran's President Rouhani Asserts, Iran Smarter Than To Fall in a Trap

Nov. 30 (EIRNS)—The rational response by Iran, Russia, and the Gulf countries' leadership to the assassination of Iranian nuclear scientist Mohsen Fakhrizadeh Nov. 27, shows that the nature of this operation is to provoke Iran to retaliate militarily against Israel and the U.S. forces in the region to ignite a new conflict in the middle of a U.S. electoral dispute. While Iranian officials and media were quick to point the finger of accusation against Israel and the U.S.-British-backed Iranian terrorist group Mujahideen-e Khalq (MEK), Iranian President Hassan Rouhani said on Nov. 28 in a televised statement: “The Iranian nation is wiser and smarter than to fall into the trap of the Zionists [Israel]. They are after chaos and sedition. They should understand that we know their plans and they will not achieve their ominous goals.” However, the President warned, “All think tanks and all enemies of Iran should know well that the Iranian nation and the country's authorities are more courageous and zealous than to let this

criminal act go unanswered. The relevant authorities will respond to this crime at the proper time.”

The Russian Foreign Ministry issued a statement saying: “We strongly condemn the assassination of Iranian scientist Mohsen Fakhrizadeh on November 27, 2020. We are seriously worried by the provocative nature of this terrorist attack, which was obviously designed to destabilize the region and exacerbate its conflict potential. Those who organized the assassination to further their political interests must be held accountable.” The statement was concluded by urging “all sides to refrain from moves that could escalate tensions.”

The Persian Gulf states of the United Arab Emirates and Bahrain both issued official statements condemning the assassination of Fakhrizadeh. The two countries have recently signed peace agreements brokered by the Trump Administration and are fully normalizing economic and cultural relations with Israel. The U.A.E. Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation issued a statement on Nov. 30 saying that the ministry “has stressed that the state of instability our region is currently going through, and the security challenges it faces, drive us all to work towards averting acts that could lead to escalation and eventually threaten the stability of the entire region.” The Ministry said that “emanating from its deep conviction on the need to pursue all means for stability in the region, it condemns the heinous assassination of Mohsen Fakhrizadeh, which could further fuel conflict in the region.” It concluded: “Given the current situation in the region, the U.A.E. calls upon all parties to exercise maximum degrees of self-restraint to avoid dragging the region into new levels of instability and threat to peace.”

While the Saudi Arabian government did not issue a similar statement, its ambassador to the UN Abdullah Al-Muallimi stated in an interview with RT Arabic that Saudi Arabia is opposed to the policy of assassinations and that “the loss of a Muslim scientist anywhere is loss of all Muslim nations.” He emphasized that Saudi Arabia calls for “avoiding of escalation and spontaneous violent reactions.”

The method of using terrorist and military actions, like the assassination of Iranian Revolutionary Guard leader Qassem Soleimani in January 2020, to generate a counterreaction from Iran, and thus start a new string of military operations, is becoming too obvious for many parties. It has to be replaced by the same diplomacy that led to the signing of the “nuclear deal,” or Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) between Iran and the five permanent members of the UN Security Council plus Germany in 2015 that guaranteed that Iran would not be developing nuclear-grade uranium. Iran claims that it never had the intention of developing nuclear weapons. However, the JCPOA was the right insurance policy for the international community. At the same time, Iran’s right to utilize nuclear technology for civilian purposes was protected. The decision by the Trump administration to withdraw from the JCPOA and impose harsh sanctions on Iran, which should be considered a big mistake, reversed that positive trend and risked tearing down the “insurance policy.” Other actors, like the Israeli hardliners and their British and American backers in the military-industrial complex, are thus enabled to trigger a major disaster by provocative acts like this assassination. The rational response by the Iranian leadership is key to preventing such an outcome.

THE NEW GLOBAL ECONOMIC ORDER

U.S. Africa Command Donates 40-Bed Field Hospital to South Africa

Nov. 30 (EIRNS)—The United States has donated a \$1.4 million, generator-powered, 40-bed field hospital—including advanced filtration systems and negative-pressure isolation chambers—to South Africa, which it launched in remote Mahikeng, capital of Northwest Province, on the border with Botswana, on Oct. 26. South African Health Minister Dr. Zweli Mkhize selected the site of Mahikeng, because of the rise in that area of COVID.

The new field hospital has 40 beds isolated by negative pressure, which will free up beds for other patients.

The hospital can operate autonomously and is equipped with eight air conditioning units, equipped with high-efficiency particulate air filtration and ultraviolet light scrubber systems to control infections. Two 2,300 kilowatt generators provide power, the U.S. African Command wrote in a Nov. 18 release. The command said it has six other 40-bed and seven more 30-bed negative pressure isolation hospitals ready for installation as part of its Humanitarian Assistance Program. One of these latter units was donated to the Kenyan Border Police, the African Command reported Nov. 23.

***Global Times* Urges Biden Let's 'Determine U.S.-China Relations' by Practical Need To End Pandemic**

Nov. 30 (EIRNS)—*Global Times* proposes in an unsigned editorial yesterday that the new U.S. administration shape its attitude toward China with respect to America's practical need to cooperate with China in its own interest, and put aside its growing hostility toward China—instead putting greater emphasis on America's practical need to cooperate with China to bring the global COVID pandemic to an end.

The editorial reports that Joe Biden's proposed national security adviser Jake Sullivan said Nov. 27 that the way to ensure that the pandemic does not recur is "by sending a very clear message to China that the United States and the rest of the world will not accept a circumstance in which we do not have an effective public health surveillance system, with an international dimension, in China and across the world going forward."

This was taken by some to mean that a Biden Administration (which Beijing has recognized) would pursue a tough policy toward China, the editorial observes. "But Sullivan is also believed to have the intent to break with the traditional definition of US national security. He noted that the 'major focus' of the Biden National Security Council (NSC)'s work, at least initially, will be on beating the pandemic and restructuring the NSC to make public health a permanent national security priority, according to *Politico*.

The editorial elaborates, "Few Chinese expect that the Biden Administration will become strategically 'moderate' toward China. Anti-

China bias is so entrenched among U.S. elites that it will shape Washington's China policy in the long run, which means the future of U.S.-China relations is likely to be gloomy. “However, China-U.S. relations go beyond the simple friend-foe identification. It involves a range of issues that can be solved only through interactions. Trump's failure to control the epidemic determined his election loss.... Cooperation between the U.S. and the WHO and major powers, including China, is key.”

And the editors conclude: “China is perceived by some Americans as a ‘strategic adversary.’ But China is a needed partner for the U.S. to address pressing problems. Let the practical needs of the two countries, not ideology, determine the trajectory of China-U.S. relations. This should be the simplest and most executable option.”

WPF's Beasley Says Other Nations Besides U.S. Must 'Step Up' in Food and Famine Crisis

Nov. 30 (EIRNS)—David Beasley, Executive Director of the World Food Program, reiterated his call for resources to supply food aid, to avert starvation amidst world hunger now threatening more than 130 million people with possible starvation due to pandemic food disruptions. Beasley spoke from South Carolina on Nov. 29 to CBS News' “Face the Nation.”

On the scale of the crisis: “There's about 36 countries now, that we feed 30 million people, that they depend on us 100%. We assist about 100 million people on any given day, week or month right now around the world, we need to move that number up to about 138 million. But there are three dozen countries.... Let me just hit a few, Yemen, Syria, South Sudan, Northeast Nigeria, D.R.C., and I could keep going from country to country to country around the world.... This is what we're looking at—we're looking at famines, destabilization and mass migration. You know, if people in the United States are struggling for food, you can imagine what is happening in Niger, Burkina Faso or South Sudan.”

Beasley said that people are forced into emigration if they can't eat. In the Syrian mass outmigration, for example, the European leaders did not step in at the right time, at the right place. “Syria was a nation of about 20

million people. The cost of supporting the Syrians in Syria is about 50 cents per day. That same Syrian ends up in Berlin or Brussels or London, it is €50 to €100 per day. And we know that people don't want to leave home. But if they don't have food and they don't have some degree of peace and stability, they will do what any of us would do for our children.”

When CBS host Margaret Brennan expressed cynicism that the U.S. will continue its role as the biggest donor to the World Food Program, Beasley replied that there is a “miracle on Pennsylvania Avenue at both ends.” Republicans and Democrats fight each other. “But when it comes to food aid and stabilizing nations and preventing famine, it's remarkable to watch the Republicans and the Democrats come together, lay aside their differences and literally do what they can. And it's been quite a miracle to see. We went from about \$1.9 billion when I arrived 3.5 years ago to now about almost \$4 billion from the United States.”

He repeated that the billionaires should “step up in a way they've never done before.” We have a “one-time extraordinary crisis.”

COLLAPSING WESTERN FINANCIAL SYSTEM

Eskom Utility Succumbs to Green Death, Could This Be Africa's 'Tipping Point?'

Nov. 30 (EIRNS)—On Tuesday Nov. 24, André de Ruyter, CEO of South Africa's state-owned power producer Eskom, said that company thinking “had [now] evolved to encourage renewable capacity rather than resisting it,” according to a report published in *Engineering News*. Speaking at webinar titled “Future of Eskom,” organized by financial services provider PSG, de Ruyter continued that not only will the company not engage in any new production from coal, but that it now plans to decommission between 8,000-12,000 MW of coal capacity over the coming 10 years. The decision to disengage from coal comes in the wake of the October announcement by Korea Electric Power Company that it would retreat from Eskom's proposed 630 MW Thabametsi coal station, currently the company's only major new plant under consideration. KEPCO's move comes after

BlackRock and other investment companies threatened disinvestment if Eskom did not cancel its coal-fired energy projects. Similar projects were cancelled in Vietnam and Indonesia—all victims of the genocidal “Reset” of the Green Finance operations.

In de Ruyter’s eyes the decision is “economics”: Coal (and nuclear) are simply too expensive, and any self-respecting CEO would come to the same conclusion. De Ruyter came to Eskom only in January, having spent the previous five years managing Nampak, a packaging company, with no experience managing a national utility dedicated to the public good. While the choice of de Ruyter was likely made for his “management ability”—Eskom has a huge debt load—his “by the numbers” endorsement of renewables may kill the company and many South Africans.

South Africa is already routinely plagued by “load-shedding” rolling blackouts—resulting from under-maintained and otherwise poorly performing equipment—and it is among the best on the continent. The decision to forgo new, large-capacity power production plants—the size of planned solar and wind installations—amounting to mere thousands of megawatts, compared with the 11,500 MW capacity increase the Energy Ministry says is required—virtually ensures that the country will not only continue to suffer, and expand, putting thousands of lives at risk.

Beyond that, the admission by Eskom’s de Ruyter may serve as a bellwether for electric producers across the entire continent, even beyond. Until now, the Green Finance Initiative ideology had spread only as far as the central banks and the financial firms connected to them. De Ruyter’s admission is the first of an actual *power producer*—away from producing sufficient power as its primary priority, to one catering to “market-enforced” criteria of the London-centered global Green Malthusian cabal.

The criminality of this narrow thinking is only multiplied by the fact that an alternative exists—or is right on the horizon—in the form of small modular reactors, or SMRs. Coal power must be maintained until nuclear energy can be fully built out.
