Will We Survive the Birth Pangs of a New Paradigm?

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—Are you sure the sun will rise for you tomorrow? Will you still be alive next week? Don't count on it unless you act on it.

The white-hot danger of nuclear war is staring us in the face. It has been coming since the 2014 beginning of the proxy war against Russia conducted on the territory of Ukraine. It has come closer with the series of escalations made by NATO in the face of the unavoidable Russian response

to threats to its security. Now that Russian President Putin has come out and said it, has said that nuclear weapons are at Russia's disposal if its existence is threatened, even some of those who have swallowed the propaganda up to now are seeing more clearly the awful potential of the end of civilization as we know it.

Ukrainian Social Media Attack on Helga Zepp-LaRouche

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—A crude attack video, denouncing Schiller Institute founder Helga Zepp-LaRouche as a Putin mouthpiece that emits lies, was posted yesterday by a YouTube site called “VolunteerInfoN,” a site as of July 28, 2022. The 80-second video was produced by “Underdog Ukraine,” whose Facebook account dates back to April 2022, that produces juvenile “superhero cartoon” images of Ukrainian heroes. Their lead image is one of a muscular Ukrainian superhero smashing Putin's chin, as the Kremlin burns in the background.

The [80-second video](#) shows clips of Zepp-LaRouche with menacing music and the following subtitles:

“The Faces of Russian Propaganda

“In Germany, the Schiller Institute has turned into a Russian propaganda channel.

“Its founders promote the narratives that are consistent with what Russia says despite an officially declared neutral stance of this analytical center.

“Helga Zepp-LaRouche is the founder of the institute. She is one of the voices of the Kremlin in Europe.

“In her articles and speeches, the politician accuses the West of deliberately attempting to demonize Russia for decades.

“Zepp-LaRouche blames NATO for the war which the Kremlin started in Ukraine.

“The Alliance provokes Russia, says Helga Zepp-LaRouche.

“Instead of supporting Ukraine, world leaders should have listened to Putin and blocked its accession to NATO and the EU, says the Schiller Institute founder.

“Like the Kremlin, Zepp-LaRouche alleges ‘widespread Russophobia in the world.’

“Freedom of speech, she says, exists today only in Russia.

“Like most pro-Russian politicians, Helga Zepp-LaRouche speaks against sanctions on Russia.

“Do not let yourself be deceived!

“#stoprussianpropaganda”

VolunteerInfoN, as one might suspect, has an empty page in their “About” section, but one can quickly grasp their psychotic mindset. They followed the attack on Zepp-LaRouche by taking video from the city of Donetsk of dead and bloody corpses of women, bombed yesterday by Ukrainian artillery, along with a bombed-out bus, with the explanation: “Russian troops shell a market area in Donetsk.” Just out-of-control psychotic. (Imagine showing footage of concentration camp victims with a headline, “American troops slaughter Jews.”)

This doesn’t stop contributions to VolunteerInfoN from being handled by “Mir & Co Foundation,” an outfit founded in August 2014, with a November 2014 grant from George Soros’s “International Renaissance Foundation.” For eight years now, Mir & Co has been raising private donations to provide ammunition and equipment for Ukrainian forces. (In 2015, a major delivery provider in Ukraine, “Nova Poshta,” added Mir & Co to its list of groups that get free service—so the ammunition shipments qualify.) Mir & Co’s role in handling contributions for the startup “VolunteerInfoN,” is the only other lead presently as to the crude attack

upon Zepp-LaRouche; but the SBU has been assigned the role of dealing with her “war crime” of strategizing and acting for peace.

STRATEGIC WAR DANGER

Brazil’s Bolsonaro Speaks at UN on Ukraine Crisis, Insists Solution Requires Dialogue

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—Speaking at the UN General Assembly debate, President of Brazil Jair Bolsonaro had the following to say about the Ukraine situation:

“We defend an immediate ceasefire, the protection of civilians and noncombatants, the preservation of critical infrastructure to assist the population, and the maintenance of all channels of dialogue between the parties in conflict....

“...[W]e have tried to avoid the hampering of dialogue channels caused by the polarization around the conflict. In this regard, we are against diplomatic and economic isolation.”

He continued: “We support all efforts to reduce the economic impacts of the crisis. But we do not believe that the best way is to adopt unilateral and selective sanctions, that are inconsistent with international law....

“The solution to the conflict in Ukraine will only be achieved through negotiation and dialogue.

“I make a plea to the parties, as well as to the entire international community: Do not miss any opportunity to end the conflict and ensure peace. The stability, security and prosperity of humankind are at serious risk if the conflict continues or spreads.”

Reading these remarks from Bolsonaro, the president of a BRICS nation, was a welcome relief after going through the speeches of such European authorities as Germany’s Olaf Scholz!

Zelenskyy Rules Out Peace Talks with Russia

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy, in a video address to the UN General Assembly yesterday, ruled out any talks with Russia to end the war. “As for the talks between Ukraine and Russia.

“Probably you have happened to hear different words from Russia about the talks—as if they were ready for them. But. They talk about the talks but announce military mobilization. They talk about the talks but announce pseudo referendums in the occupied territories of Ukraine,” Zelenskyy said, according to the English transcript on his presidential website. He said that he ruled out a solution that would contradict the “peace formula” presented by Ukraine.

Zelenskyy also demanded that Russia be stripped of its rights as a permanent member of the UN Security Council. “So long as the aggressor is a party to decision-making in the international organizations, he must be isolated from them—at least until aggression lasts. Reject the right to vote. Deprive delegation rights. Remove the right of veto—if it is a Member of the UN Security Council. In order to punish the aggressor within the institutions,” he said. Russia’s punishment, Zelenskyy insisted, should be part of the “peace formula,” in which he also includes, sanctions, blocking of trade, and compensation for damages.

Putin Mobilizes Russia To Defend Its Existence and Its Civilization

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—The day prior to his Sept. 21 national address mobilizing the nation to prepare to defeat those in the West seeking “to weaken, divide and ultimately destroy” Russia, President Vladimir Putin met with top managers from Russia’s defense industry companies to discuss how to meet the requirements for an increased supply of weapons for the broader war now faced. In opening the meeting, Putin praised the industries for having risen to the first challenges of Russia’s deployment in the Donbass, even sending representatives to the front lines to identify improvements needed in military equipment for that theater. But production capacities now must be increased, and where necessary, modernized. Defense production must be 100% national, with all imports substituted, he

advised. He noted, that with NATO throwing virtually all its weapons stocks into Ukraine, Russia's defense industry can and must study those arsenals, "and break new ground in building up our capabilities," and referenced various changes in appropriations and credit terms to facilitate this endeavor.

The next day, when Putin delivered his national address, was also the [1,160th anniversary](#) of the founding of Russian statehood. His address to a gala concert that evening marking the anniversary reflected the deep national spirit which NATO's assault has called up within Russia, a nation which, as Putin insisted, has an "uninterrupted thousand-year history which we are proud of." Sane people in the West should take note.

"During more than a millennium, our statehood has lived through many eras, including cruel enemy invasions, disunity and the tragedies of feuds, but each of these difficult periods invariably ended with the revival of the Fatherland." This was accomplished by people who in their time "created and expanded the grandeur of our Fatherland," he said, naming 32 exemplary cases, ranging from emperors such as Peter the Great and Catherine the Great, to the scientist Mikhail Lomonosov, the poet Aleksander Pushkin, Yuri Gagarin (the first human to orbit the Earth), and other leaders, military and civilian.

"For 1,160 years now, we have firmly learned that for Russia it is mortally dangerous to relax its sovereignty or renounce its interests even for a limited time. Russia's very existence has come under threat during these times.

"They can no longer expect us to make these mistakes. We will not succumb to blackmail or intimidation, and we will never betray or lose our sovereignty. By strengthening it, we are developing our country. Sovereignty is the guarantee of freedom for everyone."

Putin vowed that Russia will continue to defend its freedom and independence, culture and traditions for the sake of future generations and a great future. "We will fight for our Fatherland, for our Motherland, the only one we have, for our freedom, independence and sovereignty, for our

culture and traditions. We will defend and protect them in the name of our ancestors and our descendants, for the sake of Russia, its great history and great future.”

Scott Ritter Demands To Know, Why Is Congress Funding a Ukrainian Kill List?

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—In a Sept. 21 [Grayzone webcast](#), former Marine weapons inspector Scott Ritter and Grayzone editor Max Blumenthal discussed the implications of the Ukrainian Myrotvorets “kill list.” The Myrotvorets list is an online database maintained by Ukrainian Nazis, which contains the names and personal information of thousands of people considered enemies of the Ukrainian fascist regime and therefore targeted for “liquidation.”

Blumenthal began the discussion by recounting his Sept. 13 interview with 13-year-old Faina Savenkova, a citizen of the Lugansk People’s Republic who, along with hundreds of other children, has been put on the kill list. He then described how he himself has been subjected to a nasty targetting operation run by a Ukrainian “OSINT community” based in London (with offices in Ukraine and U.S.) called Molfar Limited. Its [website](#) states that the firm specializes in “Military investigations, fact-checks, information search and analytics,” and includes a page of “Orcs, Russian war criminals,” listing some 1,391 names.

A short video on the homepage says Molfar was formed on an unidentified “Day 1” by 35 people and 200 volunteers, to “fight” the enemy, “working nonstop” on “identification of war criminals; refutation of Russian propaganda; investigation of war crimes; a full archive of events of full-scale war; collection of the list of companies supporting Russian aggression.” “According to Ukrainian mythology molfars are magical forecasters ... we are digital molfars.” They list their partners as Myrotvorets, USAID, and CRDF Global, among others, exposed in [EIR](#).

According to Blumenthal, Molfar sent an email to hundreds of journalists claiming that he, Blumenthal, was a paid propagandist for the Russian government and offered to provide a dossier proving the claims.

Blumenthal was able to acquire the dossier, which not only provided his own personal information but also personal information for every member of his family.

Ritter picked up the discussion by pointing out that the Myrotvoret's kill list represents a very serious threat. Many people on the list have been murdered. Ritter himself is not only on the kill list, but also on what he characterized as a “parallel list,” put out by the Center for Countering Disinformation (CCD), which contains the names of 72 prominent people, including many Americans, such as Sen. Rand Paul, U.S. Senate candidate Diane Sare, Democratic Congressional candidate Geoff Young, Col. Douglas Macgregor (ret.), former Congresswoman Tulsi Gabbard, and retired CIA analyst Ray McGovern. The CCD is a branch of the Ukraine Presidency’s National Security and Defense Council, supervised directly by the U.S. State Department, USAID, and various U.S.-funded NGOs with ties to the military-industrial complex.

People on the CCD list have been labeled by Ukrainian authorities as “information terrorists” guilty of committing war crimes. The fact that the CCD is financed directly with money allocated by Congress under [Public Law 117-128](#) is seen by Ritter as a clear violation of the Second Amendment of the U.S. Constitution whereby the U.S. government is using a foreign entity in an attempt to silence Americans opposed to the Ukraine war policy through fear tactics and thus abridging their freedom of speech. Ritter is currently working with a group of constitutional lawyers seeking a federal injunction to freeze all money appropriated by Public Law 117-128 for funding the CCD. He is also seeking to force the State Department and other federal agencies to disassociate from the CCD.

Ray McGovern Recaps Recent Ukraine-Russia History

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—In an article posted to Antiwar.com today headlined “[Brainwashed for War with Russia](#),” Ray McGovern relates the historical context for the present military conflict in Ukraine, lambasting the U.S. and Western media for their deceitful coverage.

He identifies several major inflection points:

Fourteen years ago, William Burns, who was then the U.S. Ambassador to Russia, cabled Washington on Feb. 1, 2008 to relate warnings from Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov. His cable, “Nyet means nyet: Russia’s NATO enlargement redlines,” was ignored when NATO declared on April 3, 2008 that “NATO welcomes Ukraine’s and Georgia’s Euro-Atlantic aspirations for membership in NATO. We agreed today that these countries will become members of NATO.”

Eight years ago, on Feb 22, 2014, the U.S. ran a blatant coup in Kiev, appointing the government according to the prescription laid out by Victoria “Fuck the EU” Nuland in a leaked recording.

Six years ago, in June 2016, Vladimir Putin warned that Russia considered the so-called anti-ballistic missile sites in Romania and Poland as threats, given how easily the ABMs could be transformed into offensive weapons.

Nine months ago, on Dec. 17, 2021, Putin laid out security concerns and proposed agreements with the U.S. and NATO. They were essentially rejected in their entirety.

In addition to McGovern’s list, it can be added that three weeks before the special military operation, on Feb. 4, 2022 Putin met with Xi Jinping and signed a powerful joint statement. And one week before the operation began, Ukraine forces had already begun a major escalation in renewed shelling and attacks on Donbass, as attested to by the OSCE.

Yet the establishment media parrot the word “unprovoked”—possible only in an environment of deliberately withholding the truth about the history.

NEW ECONOMIC SYSTEM

African Nations Raise Real Issues at UN General Assembly Debate

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—“The real inflection point will be the world attending fully to the needs of the marginalized and forgotten. Our greatest global challenges are poverty, inequality, joblessness, and feeling excluded,” said

South Africa's Minister of International Relations and Cooperation Dr. Naledi Pandor, in her address to the UN General Assembly debate. "South Africa, like many other developing countries, faces huge developmental challenges, including in our energy sector," she said. "We need to globally address global energy shortages."

In order to achieve development, a new paradigm is needed in the world. She pointed to the need to implement a new mode of collaboration at the UN: "It is unacceptable that 77 years after its establishment, five nations wield disproportionate decision-making power in the United Nations system as a whole. Transformation must include more representative, transparent, and accountable organs of global governance. For the UN to be effective, the General Assembly must be revitalized, the Security Council must be reformed. We also cannot have a credible organization if persistent transgressors of the Charter are not held accountable."

She singled out one in particular, and it wasn't Russia: "Israel must be held accountable for its destructive actions that have significantly impaired the possibility of a two-state solution."

Kenya's President William Samoei Ruto also called for reforms of the United Nations: "Let me express the strong collective conviction of my country that the relevance, legitimacy, and moral authority of the United Nations will forever remain deficient, undermined by the absence of comprehensive reforms of the United Nations Security Council," which he said cannot properly execute its mission if it is "undemocratic and unrepresentative."

Both nations called for an end to sanctions against Zimbabwe and Cuba.

President Felix Tshisekedi of the Democratic Republic of Congo added his voice to Security Council reform, calling for two additional non-permanent seats for Africa, and two (perhaps rotating) permanent seats, with veto privileges.

While European leaders spoke about Ukraine, democracies vs. autocracies, and denigrated the Belt and Road Initiative, many nations of the world want a deliberation structure conducive to and an international order oriented around sovereign development, not the pathetic geopolitical intrigues characteristic of humanity's infancy. For example, Kenya's President Ruto stated: "Kenya joins the Secretary General in calling for the strengthening of multilateralism as the only sustainable path to a peaceful, stable and prosperous world for all. This is the imperative of our time, and the call of this moment. It is time to work on the trust deficit with stronger conviction that none of us is really safe until all of us are safe."

Western Media in Deceitful Reporting on SCO Summit in Samarkand

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—Determined to prevent its readers from learning what actually happened during the two-day summit of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization held in Samarkand, Uzbekistan, on Sept. 15-16, Western media tell a false story of rebukes to Putin and of fissures among Russia, China, and India.

The personal meetings that Russian President Vladimir Putin held with his Indian and Chinese counterparts have received the most absurd coverage. "Putin Nods to Xi's 'Concerns' and the Limits of Their Cooperation" is the headline of the coverage by the *New York Times*, which harps on a single word, "concerns," and ignores the groundbreaking [Feb. 4, 2022 joint Russian-Chinese statement](#) signed by the two Presidents in Beijing. "Rather than put on a show of Eurasian unity against the West as Russia struggled to recover from last week's humiliating military retreat ... the two leaders struck discordant notes in their public remarks—and Mr. Xi made no mention of Ukraine at all."

In lockstep with the *New York Times*, the *Wall Street Journal* chimed in that "Russia's Vladimir Putin Says China's Xi Jinping Raised 'Concerns' on Ukraine War." CNBC declared, "Putin admits China has 'concerns' over Ukraine invasion." London's *Daily Telegraph* headlined its report "Isolated Putin Left at Beijing's Mercy as His Disastrous War Backfires." CNN wrote that "Ukraine War Risks Exposing Regional Divisions."

But the actual readouts from official Russian, Chinese, and Indian channels—had these legacy media institutions deigned to consult them—paint a very different picture. Moscow’s official reporting quotes Xi that “we are ready to work with our Russian colleagues to set an example of what a responsible global power is and assume leadership in order to bring the rapidly changing world onto a path of sustainable and positive development.”

India’s Ministry of External Affairs quotes [Prime Minister Narendra Modi](#): “The relationship between India and Russia has deepened manifold. We also value this relationship because we have been such friends who have been with each other every moment for the last several decades and the whole world also knows how Russia’s relationship with India has been and how India’s relationship with Russia has been, and therefore the world also knows that it is an unbreakable friendship.”

That didn’t stop CNN from reporting that Modi “appears to have directly rebuffed Moscow’s invasion of Ukraine ... in what was the latest in a series of setbacks for the Russian leader.”

COLLAPSING WESTERN ECONOMIC SYSTEM

Truss Tells UNGA, the British Empire Will Be Revived!

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—Many UN delegates must have gagged at British Prime Minister [Liz Truss](#)’s starting premise in her late-day speech to the United Nations General Assembly debate yesterday that “Her Late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II ... symbolized the post-war values on which this organization—that is, the United Nations!—was founded.” Certainly, FDR would have!

She promised that geopolitics, like the Great Britain, is entering a new era, for which Great Britain has a “proposed blueprint ... [of] new partnerships and new instruments we need to collectively adopt,” to win the conflict between democracies and autocracies. Russia was named, and her speech was sprinkled with the usual key-and-code attacks on the Belt and

Road Initiative and China. She pressed for systematic action to be taken against the “authoritarian regimes” on the economic front, in addition to “the unprecedented sanctions, diplomatic action, and rapid military support” already deployed through NATO and the other collective security arrangements which are being cobbled together.

In other words: “The G7 and our like-minded partners should act as an economic NATO, collectively defending our prosperity. If the economy of a partner is being targeted by an aggressive regime we should act to support them. All for one and one for all,” she cried.

All for the City of London, Truss means. She spoke of how “the U.K. is providing funding, using the might of the City of London and our security capabilities to provide better alternatives to those offered by malign regimes.” (Every nation on the globe has experienced the destruction which resulted in the past several centuries when forced to turn to the City of London’s “debt free from strings,” as she called it.)

Imposing imperial “democratic values” and “progress” today, as before, requires military might. So, Truss announced that the U.K. will spend 3% of GDP on defense by 2030, “maintaining our position as the leading security actor in Europe. And that’s why—at this crucial moment in the conflict—I pledge that we will sustain or increase our military support to Ukraine, for as long as it takes. New U.K. weapons are arriving in Ukraine as I speak—including more MLRS rockets. We will not rest until Ukraine prevails....

“As we mourn our Late Queen ... we must devote ourselves to this task. Britain’s commitment to this is total,” she declared.

German Government Runs Hundreds of Online Nazis and Extremists

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—Hundreds of “radical Nazi” and “right-wing extremists,” plying their trade online, are actually being run by the German government and its Federal Office for the Protection of the Constitution (BfV). A female German domestic intelligence agent told the Sept. 19 issue of *Süddeutsche Zeitung* that she joined the effort to “do something against

right-wing extremists,” but, as she explained, “In order to be really credible, it is not enough to share or like what others say, you also have to make statements yourself. That means that the agents also bully and agitate.” Their job is to “feed” the scene.

Süddeutsche Zeitung author Ronen Steinke cites the new 10-point plan of Interior Minister Nancy Faeser to “fight right-wing extremism,” but as the BfV explained it, this includes the opposition Alternative for Germany party. So, not only is it fair game to listen in on their phone calls and to read their emails, but also they are “playing a little right-wing radical” game themselves, including the creation and dissemination of vile “propaganda” to gain the trust of others and sometimes “incitement to hatred.”

As the American newspaper cartoon strip Pogo explained it years ago, “We have met the enemy, and he is us.”

UNITED STATES POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC

New York Civil Suit Against Trump and Family

Sept. 22 (EIRNS)—New York Attorney General Letitia James has filed a civil suit against Donald Trump, several of his children, the Trump Organization, and other businesses associated with him. The fraud suit accuses the Trumps of falsely inflating Trump’s net worth “to induce banks to lend money to the Trump Organization on more favorable terms than would otherwise have been available to the company.” James is suing for \$250 million and the removal of the Trumps from their positions at the Trump Organization.
