World Waking Up to the Evil of the Climate Hoax

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—The ghouls have begun arriving in Glasgow for the witches' coven scheduled to be launched the day after tomorrow, on Hallowe'en, hoping to convince the world to ignore the collapsing economies and the hyperinflation in energy, food, housing and more, in order to "save the planet." The streets of Glasgow are flooded from a rainstorm, with roads closed, cars abandoned, and the trains not running. A second "yellow weather warning" was released for a new storm to hit the area on Saturday, Oct. 30. As in New York, when residential areas were flooded (and people died) after Hurricane Ida roared through in September, the flooding is not caused by nature, but by the lack of adequate infrastructure. But, of course, the COP26 folk will tell you it was caused by global warming, although some may be privately fearing it is a "sign" of God's displeasure with their Satanic planning for global genocide.

The real signs, however, are coming from nations across the globe, telling the royals and billionaires behind COP26 that their intentions have been exposed by the real world impact of their Green "Reset." Russia, China and India have made clear that they are expanding, not contracting, the use of coal and other fossil fuels, to provide the energy needed for the development and livelihood of their citizens. Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni spoke for all of Africa, when he wrote, in an op-ed in the *Wall Street Journal* on Oct. 24, headlined, "[Solar and Wind Force Poverty on Africa](#)": "Africa can't sacrifice its future prosperity for Western climate goals."

The Schiller Institute has issued a statement, which will be circulated internationally in several languages: "Do You Want To Avoid Freezing on Christmas and Starving in the Spring? Stop the Great Gas Shock Swindle." It states that the hyperinflated gas prices have been artificially created by the same City of London and Wall Street financial interests that orchestrated the "oil shock" in 1973. While trying to blame the inflation on

the “recovery,” or on Russia, the truth is that “their policy of financial speculation, the Green climate swindle, and hyperinflationary money printing” have manufactured the crisis, the statement reports. It calls for an international mobilization with five demands: license Nord Stream 2; exclude financial traders from energy and food markets; restore Glass-Steagall; replace speculative “spot markets” with long-term contracts among nations; and bring together the major powers for a New Bretton Woods to replace the broken monetary system with a credit system for global reconstruction.

CULTURAL COLLAPSE

New Escalation in the Confrontation between the EU and Poland

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—In an escalating move in the confrontation with Poland, the [European Court of Justice](#) imposed a fine of €1 million per day for failing to implement a previous ECJ ruling to dissolve Poland’s Disciplinary Chamber of the Supreme Court.

The ECJ ruling had been rejected by the Polish Constitutional Court, and Prime Minister Mateusz Morawiecki had asserted the primacy of national law over EU law in a speech before the EU Parliament and the EU Commission last week.

In a related move, the European Network of Councils of Justice (ENCJ) expelled Poland yesterday. The ENCJ is a coordinating body between the Commission and all European Councils of Justice, its members being members of the National Councils.

In an interview with the *Financial Times* published Oct. 24, [Morawiecki](#) had warned the EU that if the European Commission “starts the third world

war” by withholding promised Covid recovery cash to Warsaw, he would “defend our rights with any weapons which are at our disposal.”

Responding to the escalation against Warsaw, European Parliament Identity and Democracy Group chairman Marco Zanni tweeted that “Trampling the sovereignty of nation states will lead the Union towards its disintegration.”

Interestingly, Bavarian daily, *Augsburger Allgemeine*, speculated on Oct. 28 that if Brussels tightens the rope too much, Warsaw could veto the EU Green Deal.

Cheminade Argues, Stop EU Judicial Putsch Against All Sovereign Member States

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—On his weekly webcast Oct. 21, Jacques Cheminade, president of Solidarité & Progrès French political party, fully supported the ruling of the Polish tribunal to uphold the primacy of its own Constitution with respect to the EU Treaty. He showed that the French Constitution is on the same line, and called the EU attacks against Poland a “judicial putsch.”

On Oct. 7 the Polish Constitutional Court ruled that two articles of the Treaty of the European Union are in violation of the Polish Constitution insofar as they allow the nation’s Constitution to be set aside on behalf of European law. The Polish court did not condemn the EU Treaty itself, but the principle that European law should have primacy over Poland’s national Constitutional rules. The Polish court found that European law applies as a priority only in the predefined fields of jurisdiction. It is therefore the European Court of Justice that is encroaching and violating the law, using a European Court of Justice decision (*Costa v ENEL*) dating back to the times of the European Commission (1964), and not the Polish Supreme Court.

Cheminade went back to the crucial political and judicial decisions which have led France to uphold its Constitution over other legal texts, except when its leaders have gone into a “voluntary submission” to foreign dictates, which has tended to be the case in recent years.

The speech on the EEC founding Treaty of Rome by former head of government Pierre Mendès France on Jan. 18, 1957, expresses the philosophy well: “The abdication of a democracy can take two forms: whether by recourse to a domestic internal dictatorship, by handing over all power to a providential man, or by delegation of power to an outside authority which, under technical cover, in reality exercises political power, since in the excuse of a healthy economy it could comfortably dictate monetary, budgetary, and social policy—ultimately, a national and international “policy,” in the greatest sense of the word.

“If France is prepared to undertake its improvement within the framework of fraternal cooperation with the other European countries, it will admit only those ways and means of improvement imposed from outside, even under cover of automatic processes.”

For these reasons, Article 54 of the French Constitution specifies that if France signs a treaty whose provisions go against the Constitution, the Constitution must be amended before the Treaty can be applied. Article 55 then becomes problematic insofar as it states that “treaties and agreements regularly ratified or approved, have, from the moment they are published, a superior authority to that of laws, on condition, for each agreement and treaty, that it is also applied by the other party.” However, it was overruled by a decision of France’s State Council (the highest judicial authority on administrative matters) of Oct. 30, 1998, which states that “the supremacy conferred by Article 55 of our Constitution to the international commitments does not apply in the internal order to provisions of a Constitutional nature.” This decision, taken in the context of a ruling concerning New Caledonia (Sarran-Levasseur) was then upheld by the Council of State and by the Supreme Court, and it’s considered as one of the major decisions of our times on matters of hierarchy or norms.

Finally, beyond all these arguments, which are valid in courts, there is Article 2 of the French Constitution upholding the “government of the people, for the people, and by the people,” which overrules everything else.

STRATEGIC WAR DANGER**JSC Vice Chair General Hyten Says China Has Abandoned 'Minimum Deterrence' Policy**

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—In what *Breaking Defense* referred to as his likely “valedictory remarks,” to reporters yesterday, Vice Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Gen. John Hyten expressed the view that the evidence, including publicly available satellite imagery of new ICBM fields under construction, shows that China has abandoned its past policy of minimum deterrence. “You don’t need to develop the kind of capabilities they’re developing for a minimum deterrence. The work they’re doing on hypersonics, the work to fill out the triad, the work to build both a fixed-base ICBM program and a mobile ICBM program at the same time, to put ballistic missiles on bombers, to put ballistic missiles on submarines—you know, when you look at that structure, that is not a minimum deterrence model,” Hyten said. “What I worry about is capability. And if you’re a military officer, you have to worry about the capability and the possibility that an adversary will use that capability against you.”

Overall, Hyten called the rapid rise of the Chinese military “stunning.” “The pace they’re moving and the trajectory that they’re on will surpass Russia and the United States if we don’t do something to change it,” he said. “We have to do something.” Hyten apparently did not say what that “something” might be, however.

Despite worries about China, Hyten still called Russia the greatest existential threat to the U.S. “Russia is still the most imminent threat, simply because they have 1,500 deployed nuclear weapons, plus or minus, and China’s got roughly 20% of that,” he said. “So, you have to worry about Russia in the near term.”

“They already have operational hypersonic capabilities with nuclear weapons on it,” Hyten said of Russia. “And they continue to experiment with hypersonics, but not nearly at the pace of China, not anywhere close to the pace of China.”

Hyten told [TASS](#) that it's important to expand the military-to-military dialogue with Russia. "I think General Milley and General Gerasimov have a good relationship. I think that the strategic stability talks are making progress. We are looking to expand these relationships as I said earlier," Hyten said. "I think, when you're talking—and we are talking with Russia right now—I'm much happier. And we are talking. I think we need to expand that."

GREEN NEW DEAL

FLOP26's 'Deluge'—Rain, Garbage and Rats—Not What the Queen Ordered

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—The city of Glasgow is, as of this writing, a flooded mess, with the U.K. Met Office "yellow weather" warning extending into noon tomorrow as guests are arriving for what is looking more like the real Flop26. Torrential rains have flooded the streets, forcing some people to abandon their cars, stopping traffic, halting train service from London to Glasgow, etc., raising the question of how people are going to be able to get to the Malthusian lovefest scheduled to begin on Hallwe'en on Sunday. The small city of Glasgow is overwhelmed. The *Washington Post* today reports that on the eve of the summit, trash collectors are threatening to go out on strike, which would certainly be an embarrassment; but even if they don't, trash and recyclables are collected only three times a month, leading to overflowing trash cans and dumpsters and a big increase in the rat population.

And all this is taking place against a backdrop of a full-blown energy crisis, which the weekly *The Spectator* blames on the green movement's push for renewables, added to which was the U.K.'s decision to reduce domestic storage capacity during the COVID pandemic, and failing to carry out maintenance on the all-important North Sea gas rigs. Calmer weather has also caused many wind turbines built around the U.K. to cease operating. No wonder coal stations are being restarted. With fuel and food

shortages, *The Spectator* points out, this is no time to be talking about net zero emissions.

All of this could amount to a big political setback for Boris Johnson, and even for the broader environmental movement, the weekly reports, because there will be such a sharp contrast between expectations and actual results, combined with a severe energy crisis. Aside from the no-shows—Putin, Xi, Japan’s Kishida and Modi undecided—there is the other problem that developing countries are demanding many billions of dollars to cover the cost of meeting emission reduction demands. A meeting held in London last July estimated that developing nations would initially need \$100 billion annually which would eventually increase to \$700 billion. Another leaked draft resolution that came out of this same meeting was that production and consumption of vegan meat should be promoted—which didn’t sit well with Australia, Argentina, Brazil and other beef producers.

Developing Nations Not Jumping on the COP26 Bandwagon, But Have No Good Alternatives

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—Britain’s *Daily Express* tabloid reports that COP26’s President Alok Sharma is very anxious about getting all countries, especially developing countries belonging to the G20, to agree to the 1.5° Celsius target which is a goal of COP26, “We have to get that,” Sharma says. But the problem is that there are 24 developing nations, among them China, India, Indonesia, Saudi Arabia, Egypt, the Philippines and Malaysia, grouped in the Like-Minded Developing Countries (LMDC), that aren’t playing ball and don’t intend to be squeezed into an anti-development trap in the way that the depopulation fanatics are demanding. These nations for the most part don’t have well thought-out programmatic alternatives, but they have made clear what they don’t want.

In a meeting last week, the ministers of the LMDC issued a strong statement criticizing rich countries for insisting on the need for a universal goal of net-zero by 2050. “This new ‘goal’ which is being advanced runs counter to the Paris Agreement and is anti-equity and against climate justice,” the Oct. 18 statement read. The LMDC argument is that they

shouldn't be forced into the same timeline as industrialized nations for cutting emissions, since they weren't the ones that contributed to historic emissions—and may want to use fossil fuels for their own economic development just as wealthier nations have done. The green, Seattle-based media organization Grist points out that developed countries have delayed taking action for more than a decade in cutting their own emissions but now are demanding that the whole world commit to net zero.

Sharma's call to the G20 countries, some of which belong to the LMDC, to take action now and set a net-zero target, didn't get the response he wanted. Instead they proposed that the rich countries first get on a fast track, and fully decarbonize by the end of this decade, and then “leave the remaining atmospheric space” for carbon emissions to the developing world. This is where the money issue comes in. According to Eddy Perez, international diplomacy manager of Climate Action Network Canada, the LMDC are issuing a clear call for the U.K. to ensure that negotiations are fair. “It can't just be about mitigation pledges,” Perez remarks. “Keeping 1.5° C within reach requires urgently scaling up adaptation support and mobilizing trillions of dollars.” There is much criticism of the U.S. for failing to bring to Glasgow the climate change package that Joe Biden had promised, and demands that these richer nations have to both cut emissions and fork over the trillions of dollars needed by developing nations. Who's going to buy that?

Rosneft, Gazprom Leaders Prove Green Economy Is Populist and Won't Change Climate Change

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—The heads of Russian energy groups Gazprom and Rosneft spoke at the 14th Eurasian Economic Forum in Verona, Italy. The two Russian business leaders blasted the so-called Green Transition as populist and useless. “The world will face climate change even if it reaches carbon neutrality goals by 2050,” said Rosneft CEO Igor Sechin, reported TASS. “The Earth's climate has never been static, and even after reaching the carbon-neutral goals by 2050, humanity will still face climate changes,” he said.

At the same time, he remarked that energy transition to zero carbon is possible only if the stability of energy supplies and the development of new technologies are maintained. “The development of new materials is no longer an energy issue, but a much more serious issue of changing the structure of the economy. Despite the variety of plans to reach carbon neutrality, the energy transition will remain a pipedream without developing new technologies and materials. Even in the long-term renewable energy will not be able to completely replace traditional energy resources,” he said.

Supporters of complete refusal to invest in the oil and gas sector ignore the risks of market imbalance, Sechin went on. “This year has clearly shown that wrong decisions in the field of climate policy can lead to serious negative consequences for the entire global economy and society.”

Sechin believes that the climate agenda puts pressure on oil and gas prices, and not the OPEC Plus policy. “Pressure from climate activists stops the implementation of joint projects with international companies, which forces majors to cut investments in oil and gas production, redirecting funds to renewable energy. It is the climate agenda that is now putting pressure on the global oil and gas market,” he argued.

Meanwhile, the gas crisis may cause additional demand for oil in the amount of 1 million barrels per day, which could further increase oil prices, he declared. “According to Citi and Goldman Sachs, ultra-high prices for natural gas could create additional demand for oil in the amount of up to 1 million barrels per day, which will increase imbalance similar to gas, and will further increase oil prices,” Sechin explained.

Gazprom Chairman of the Board Viktor Zubkov warned that “we cannot ignore threats against gas, as a transition fuel, which we see in Europe. There are those who call for stopping investments in gas but prices are now beating all records—and yet, populists call for the Green Economy.”

“Gazprom is able to supply 1.7 billion cubic meters of gas a day to Europe. This year, we delivered 11 bcm of gas more than planned to Europe and we are ready to supply 55 billion more,” Zubkov declared,

explaining that “long-term contracts not only give stability, but also involve large investment figures. By 2050, the gas share of the energy mix will grow by 57%,” Zubkov was quoted as saying by Italian media.

The 14th Eurasian Economic Forum in Verona is traditionally organized by the Roscongress Foundation, the St. Petersburg International Economic Forum, and the Italian non-profit association Conoscere Eurasia. The Oct. 28-29 forum involves Russian and Italian business leaders, politicians, experts and high-ranking foreign representatives. Russian President Vladimir Putin sent a message of greeting to the event.

U.S. Opposition to Biden’s Climate Policies Draws Interest in Chinese Media

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—The lead editorial in the *Global Times* today takes note that Joe Biden’s own party has blocked his effort to pass climate change legislation, and that the Republican Party will likely scrap anything the Democrats pass if they come back into power. The daily writes that whether China and the U.S. can “unite and cooperate will determine the future of the entire operation on climate change.”

The editors continued: “The promise of the Biden administration is eye-catching, but there are widespread international doubts about how Washington can ensure the fulfillment of this promise, where its leverage is and how it will ensure the sustainability of the policy. In the U.S., only the Democratic government supports the UN climate action. The previous Trump administration blatantly withdrew from the Paris Agreement and threw the entire UN climate action aside. The Biden administration is like a truant returning to class. However, once the Republican Party comes to power, it will be highly uncertain whether the U.S. will ‘skip class’ again and whether the Biden administration’s commitment will be overturned again. The G20 summit and the COP26 global climate summit are coming soon, but Biden’s \$1.75 trillion budget plan focusing on climate change and other issues has not been approved. This has further worsened Biden’s credibility.”

Romanian City's Heating Systems Go Bankrupt, 56,000 Families Have No Heat

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—Timisoara, a major city in western Romania, was left without public heating on Oct. 26. Approximately 55,000 families, plus all the schools and all but two hospitals were left without central heating as temperatures dropped near freezing, Romanian media reported Oct. 27. The mayor reported that Odobescu Maternity Hospital and Victor Babeş Hospital, The German natural gas suppliers E.ON Romania and Delgaz stopped distribution of gas to the two public heating producers in the municipality of Timisoara (CET Centru and Colterm. Colterm was declared to be bankrupt on Oct. 26 and owes €15.3 million to E.ON. In the past months the city had to negotiate gas contracts on a daily basis and make payment in advance.

One reason for Colterm's bankruptcy is the millions of euros it has had to pay since 2006 for carbon emissions. Colterm didn't buy all its carbon emission certificates for 2020 and was fined of €21.6 million. Hospitals and schools are impacted. The maternity ward of Timisoara had to move all the infants to with electrical heating, while the mothers live with heating at 15° C. In other hospitals, patients received an extra blanket.

At the same time, Romania is undergoing severe crises, with the liberal coalition government collapsing on Oct. 5, and the COVID pandemic taking some 400 lives a day.

Timisoara may just be the first city to suffer late autumn heating crises: With the high gas and carbon certificates prices, many Romanian cities face heating difficulties. "The additional costs are so high that, without government intervention, all these operators—we are 27 municipalities—risk going bankrupt," said Bacău Mayor Lucian Vizite. The power plant in Deva was shut down this spring. Bucharest, which has the biggest central heating network in Europe, after Moscow, heats 562,000 apartments: Its heating distributor could go bankrupt.

Timisoara's Mayor Dominic Fritz, is searching for another gas supplier and made an appeal to the gas market, ironically asking it for "humanity."

Fritz is member of a new ultraliberal, pro-European Union party, USR, which made an urgent call to the EU Commission: “E.ON Gaz Romania’s unilateral decision to stop gas supply contradicts the principles ... to safeguard the gas supply. The EU ... should also ensure that no European company can jeopardize the energy security of individual municipalities.” They leave out that their fight “against corruption,” included coal phase-out and market liberalization. In 1990, with vast coal and gas resources, and its own nuclear fuel-producing cycle, Romania was energy self-sufficient. Since then, the “invisible hand” liberalized the energy market, with gas fully liberalized in 2020 and electric energy in 2021.

If only these young EU-boosted liberals faced the consequences of their ideology, it might be enough, but as Timisoara’s newborns and mothers can testify, tens of thousands in just that city may risk their lives as “global warming” goes out the window this winter.

U.S. Foundations Funded ‘Canadian-Based’ Environmentalist Initiatives, Alberta Province Inquiry Reports

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—Ten days before the COP26 depopulation conference was set to begin on Hallwe’en in Glasgow, Scotland, the [Public Inquiry into Anti-Alberta Energy Campaigns](#) submitted their Report to the Alberta government on Oct. 21.

The report revealed that: “Total foreign funding of ‘Canadian-based’ environmental initiatives was \$1.28 billion between 2003 and 2019. The Commissioner states that these figures are likely significantly understated.” Some \$897 million went to 31 Canadian environmentalist NGOs, nearly \$22 million to 6 environmental legal organizations, and a further \$6 million to other anti-Alberta resource organizations. “A further \$352 million in foreign funding of ‘Canadian-based’ environmental initiatives, such as anti-pipeline campaigns, remained in the U.S.”

Alberta Energy Minister Sonya Savage commented: “It was a lot of money, coming from across the border, from foreign jurisdictions that came in to influence domestic policy, to influence legislation and regulatory

matters. It hurts people in Alberta, it hurts the province's oil and gas sector. We have a right to be mad, we have a right to be outraged.”

It was investigative journalist Vivian Krause's decade-long original research on foreign funding by U.S. foundations of Canadian environmentalist groups that was instrumental in getting Alberta's Conservative Premier Jason Kenny to establish the Public Inquiry into Anti-Alberta Energy Campaigns in July 2019.

Krause's expertise and methodology were unfortunately only given lip-service by Inquiry Commissioner Steve Allan, an accountant, who hired the accounting firm of Deloitte to produce a heavily redacted 697-page report and who unabashedly exclaimed in an interview “No individual or organization, in my view, has done anything illegal.... Indeed, they have exercised their rights of free speech.”

Key findings of Vivian Krause's relentless exposures were featured in a short documentary: “[Over a Barrel Documentary \(2019\)](#).”

Krause in 2008 had shed a spotlight on the sleight of hand of “re-granting” foundation money in order to mask the donor identity of large established foundations and protect them from any possible legal action for their subversive funding activities against foreign governments.

Krause noticed that CorpEthics Strategic Advisers to Environmental Campaigns (originally named Corporate Ethics International), a San Francisco-based operation, had originally written on their website—“the strategy was to land-lock the tar sands so their crude oil could no longer reach international markets where it could fetch a high price.”

In 2008, the Rockefeller Brothers Fund had given money to CorpsEthics which posted the mandate that was given to them: “to recruit the groups, develop the strategy, create a coordinated campaign, and act as a re-granting agency for the North American Tar Sands Campaign.”

Krause also identified the Tides Foundation, which she identified as “a pass-through vehicle that provides public relations insulation for the

money's original donors," as another major laundromat for the "Canadian-based" environmental initiatives of the Hewlett Foundation.

German Government Seeks To Tax 'Dirty' Sectors of Economy To Fund Renewables

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—On the eve of the COP26 summit, the German Agency for the Environment (Umweltbundesamt, UBA) went public with a radical call for an end to all state subsidies and tax cuts for the "dirty" sectors of the economy like transportation, agriculture, energy generation. As UBA President Dirk Messner put it, "time is running out for climate protection," therefore urgent action is required. The UBA presented a paper yesterday, asserting that if subsidies and tax cuts in the range of €65 billion annually are canceled, funds for so-called "renewables" (interruptibles, to be accurate) could be mobilized without having to increase general taxes.

Messner also called for eliminating tax cuts for agriculture's diesel use and proposed taxing meat products and cutting taxes for non-meat products.

Pope Francis Continues His Blasphemous Worship of Mother Earth

Oct. 29 (EIRNS)—Pope Francis disappointed the oligarchs running the COP26 climate forum by not attending in person, but he is doing his best to support the Satanists, telling BBC in an exclusive interview that "each of us—whoever and wherever we may be—can play our own part in changing our collective response to the unprecedented threat of climate change and the degradation of our common home." Recall that the Pope's encyclical *Laudato Si'* was issued before the 2015 Paris UN Climate Conference, openly embracing the green program of Prince Charles and Hans Joachim ("Sir John") Schellnhuber, CBE, who want to reduce the world's population to pre-industrial age levels, less than 1 billion human souls.

The Pontiff also met today with President Joe Biden. The meeting was private, but Papa Joe gave the Il Papa a present—a military coin that he said American Presidents award their warrior generals, calling Francis a "warrior for peace." (More accurately, as Friedrich Schiller identified, "the peace of the graveyard.")
